There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition attend the virtual hearing and are willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should request an interpreter attend the meeting with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

My name is \_\_\_\_\_ and I am a resident in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Ward. Many community members including myself have concerns about consistent noise violations relating to cars in the parking lots near the intersection of Chicago St and Lincoln Memorial Dr. Various car enthusiasts are congregating in these parking lots on multiple evenings/nights throughout the week where they spin-out their tires and see how fast they can accelerate. Not only does this seem like unsafe behavior but it affects the quality of life of the residents in the area.

My suggestion would be to gate off the parking lots they are using and consider a small police presence in the area during the evenings; I doubt it will take much to deter them.

Just providing an update on the situation with the car enthusiasts. Nothing has changed. The cars show up on a nightly basis. My wife and I take turns calling dispatch every single night.

There are multiple entrances to the parking lot that they use; it is the same lot every single time. Given that this is a private lot would it not be reasonable to fine the owners of the lot since the violation is occurring on their property? Is there something special about parking lots that the owners aren't responsible for violations occurring on their property?

Clearly no action is going to take place from the owners until more drastic measures are taken. Multiple community members and our household are willing to gather evidence or create a petition if needed. I appreciate the feedback so far and would really like to get ahead of this thing as we move into the summer.

Hello,

Thank you for your response. The police have been very responsive and helpful, and we acknowledge that they have competing urgent priorities that require attention. Their responses do not end up in violations or fines given to the drivers, so the drivers just keep returning and the problem isn't solved. We feel that in order to effectively prevent the drag racers from coming to the area, the property owners need to be held accountable. They have done nothing to stop this from happening. They could simply put up a functional gate to prevent access or limit access to paying customers. Are there any requirements or actions that the property owners can be held accountable for? Can this be addressed when negotiating their license renewal? Does the disruption to the neighborhood violate their license contract agreement? Basically, I am trying to determine how we can engage the property owners and motivate them to resolve the issue without making it the local residents and the police's problem.

Installing speed bumps is an interesting idea and something we believe would be worth exploring.

The lot is not part of the Italian Community Center. I circled the lot in the attached image.

I am sorry this disorder is continuing. This disorder is and remains primarily a police matter. Other city departments can install traffic calming features such as speed humps on Jackson St or other streets and install curb bump outs and traffic circles among others to slow traffic. We are open to any specific suggestions you might have. Actual physical changes to roadway geometry can take time to plan, engineer and implement and council approval is required for some of these installations. My office can initiate traffic calming installations but my office has no control over police deployments. I can say however that police resources have been stretched very thin this summer given the Bucks playoffs, disorder in downtown entertainment districts and the dramatic increase in homicides and shootings across the city. I am sure they are doing the best they can with the tools they have available.

I am a resident and \_\_\_\_\_ of \_\_\_\_\_ building in the Third Ward. My husband \_\_\_\_\_ contacted you a couple months ago about noise concerns of people racing cars in the area. We are still having the same issues, mainly in the 328 N Jackson St lot, but also when these individuals race and rev their engines on the streets in the Third Ward. The police officers have been very responsive and helpful when called, but we need an actual solution rather than being expected to call every time they assemble. At times it can take up to 20-30 minutes to even get a hold of someone on the non-emergency line, and residents of the area cannot be expected to interrupt their lives to do this every time.

Many of our residents have echoed the same frustrations, which has even contributed to one moving out. Our board has reached out to our attorney for support, and we were advised to request this issue to be brought to the appropriate committee for action. Your assistance would be greatly appreciated in doing this. We will begin to assemble a group of residents interested in supporting resolution of this issue.

Please let me know what actions are being taken to help resolve this issue permanently.

The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 11/09/2021 at 9:25 AM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at <http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel>. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or [stasst5@milwaukee.gov](mailto:stasst5@milwaukee.gov) for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

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## Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
  - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
  - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
  - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
  - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

**Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.**


