Re: Formal Objection to the Opening of JJ's Chicken and Fish at 3057 N. 35th Street

Dear Members of the Board,

I am writing to formally object to the approval of the occupancy and operation of JJ's Chicken and Fish at 3057 N. 35th Street, which is located directly behind my home at 3056 N. 36th Street.

I have several serious concerns regarding the impact this restaurant would have on my property, my personal safety, and the quality of life in our neighborhood:

1. Operating Hours:

The proposed hours of operation — open until 2:00 AM five days a week and 11:00 PM the other two days — are completely inappropriate for a residential neighborhood. Late-night hours encourage loitering and could attract criminal activity. I am particularly concerned because making me vulnerable to potential crime late at night or early in the morning.

- 2. Odors and Air Quality:
  During the spring and summer months, I often

  . A restaurant specializing in fried
  chicken and fish will inevitably create strong odors that will permeate
  my home and clothes daily, significantly diminishing my enjoyment
  and use of my property.
- 3. Trash and Litter:
  Although the business may have trash cans, patrons often discard food containers and waste improperly. I am concerned about increased litter

on my property and the surrounding area, as well as the strain this would place on the neighborhood's cleanliness and maintenance.

#### 4. Rodents and Insects:

I have never had issues with rodents or insect infestations in my home.

However, the operation of a late-night restaurant could attract pests such as rats, mice, and roaches, creating unsanitary conditions for nearby residents.

5. Neighborhood Safety and Nuisance:

The area near 35th Street where Fond du Lac connects with Burleigh is already known for heavy foot traffic and occasional loitering. Adding a late-night restaurant would further increase this problem, creating a public nuisance and compromising the safety of residents like myself, especially since

6. Prior Representations:

At a hearing in 2022, it was stated that the business would not open. It is concerning that in 2025, the owner is now seeking an occupancy permit despite prior assurances. This shift undermines trust in the approval process and raises questions about accountability.

7. Zoning and Neighborhood Character:

JJ's Chicken and Fish would drastically change the character of our neighborhood. Unlike other standing restaurants that have been long-established, this would introduce a brand-new commercial operation into a previously non-commercial space, which is inappropriate for this residential area.

While I understand that the business owner may have invested money into this venture, the needs and safety of the existing residents should come first. Our neighborhood does not need another JJ's, and certainly not one operating during the early morning hours in a residential block.

I respectfully ask the Board to deny the occupancy permit for JJ's Chicken and Fish at this location. Thank you for considering my concerns seriously.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 6/24/2025 at 8:30 AM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

#### Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.


