Regarding: Your Class A Malt and Food Dealer License Applications as agent for "Punjab Food LLC" for "J&C El Centario Market" at 2082 S Muskego Av.

There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans; or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. ADDITIONAL COMMENTS/RECOMMENDATIONS:

The applicant is purchasing the store from the current licensee. The current store sells glass tire gauges and Chore Boy scrub brushes, which was explained to the applicant that they are used for smoking crack cocaine. The applicant then stated that she does not want to sell those items if they are used as drug paraphernalia. The premise has working digital cameras, however, the applicant does not know how they operate, I stressed to the applicant the importance of learning the camera system. I also advised the applicant to attend Robbery Prevention Training, and provided her with the number to schedule. The premise does also not have an approved safe, and I advised the applicant of the importance with securing safes for the business.

City of Milwaukee, Wisconsin



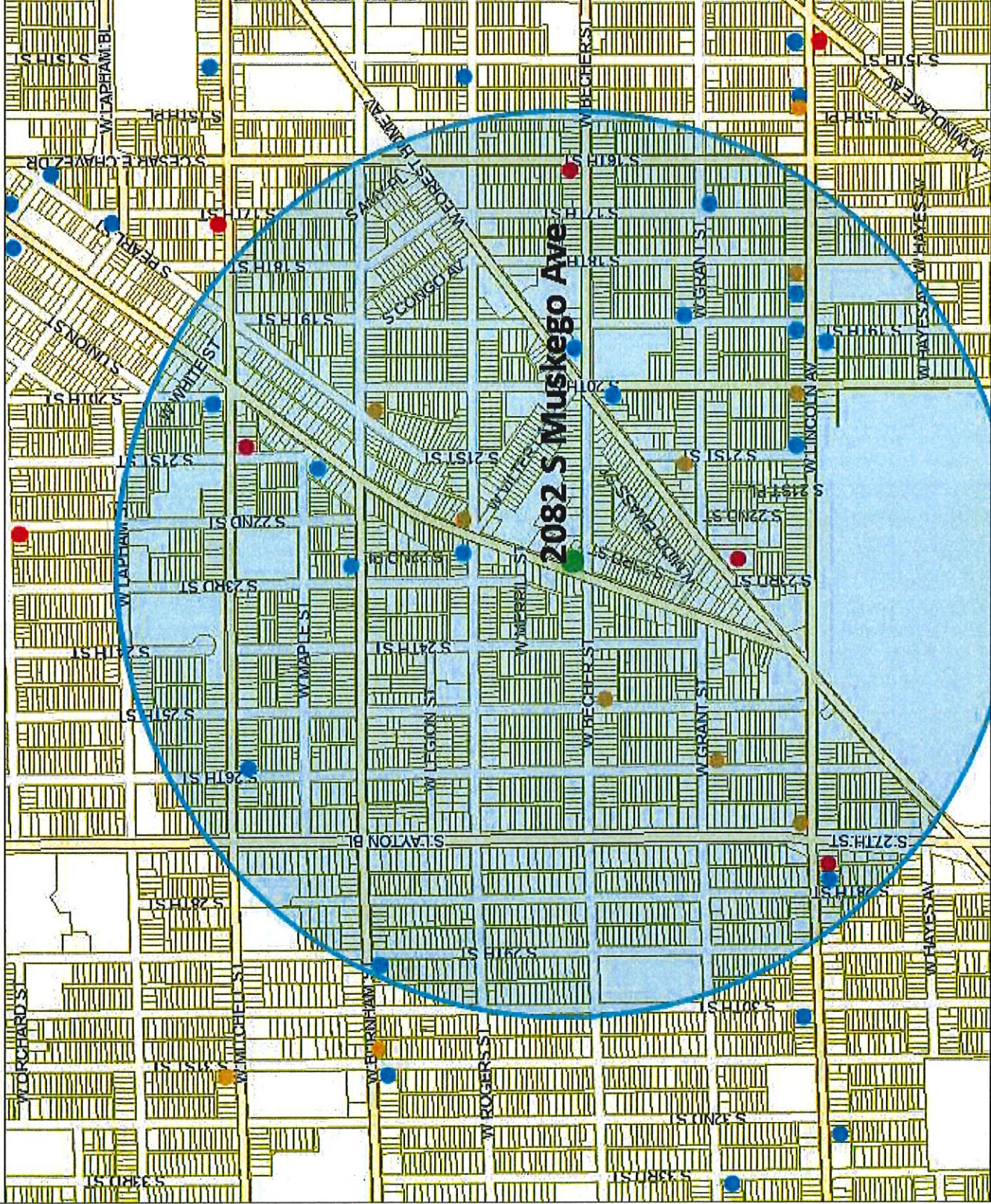

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

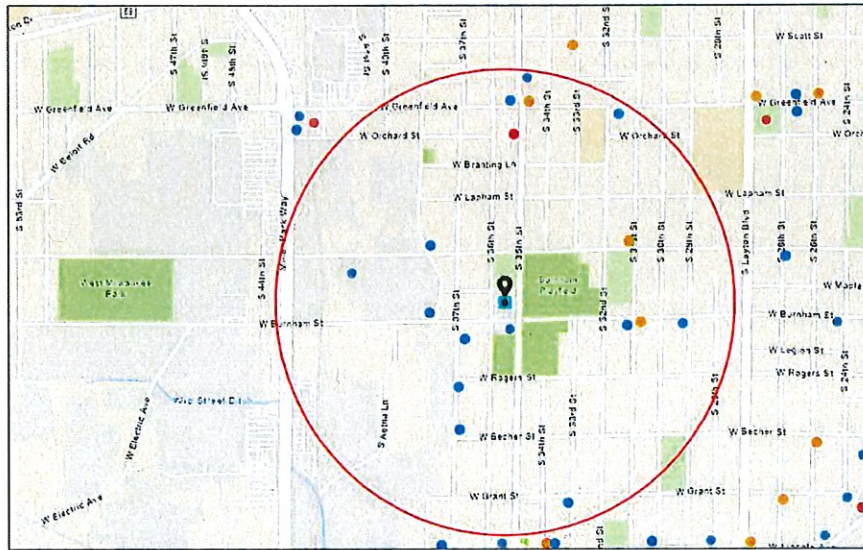


Concentration Map

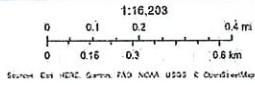

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 12/03/2016 officers received an anonymous call of a shooting at Milwaukee Nights Pub, 3830 W. National Av. The officers arrived on scene and determined the call was not legitimate.
2. On 02/07/2017 at 12:15am officers were dispatched to a noise complaint at Milwaukee Night Pub, 3830 W. National Av. The officers arrived and found the music inside was at a reasonable level but did increase when patrons opened the front door. The officer advised the bar to lower the music to fix this problem.
3. On 04/15/2017 at 2:11am officers responded to shots fired in the area of S. 38th St and W. National Av. Milwaukee Nights Pub was closed when officers arrived but the applicant was on scene and interviewed. She stated she told by her security that something was happening outside and she should close. She closed down but is not aware of what happened outside. Her security stated he was outside when he heard what sounded like two gun shots coming from around S. 39th St. The officers found no witnesses or evidence of shots being fired.
4. On 05/04/2017 officers conducted underage tavern enforcement in District 2. An underage Police Aid attempted to gain entry to Milwaukee Nights Pub, 3830 W. National Av. The Police Aid was turned away by security when she could not provide ID.

5. On 05/15/2017 officers were dispatched to a noise complaint at Milwaukee Nights Pub, 3830 W. National Av. The officers arrived and did not find the noise level to be excessively loud. They spoke with Steven ESTRADA who agreed to turn the music down because he did not want any problems. He stated the neighbors have his phone number and will text when the music is loud and he will turn it down. The staff was cooperative with the officers.

6. On 02/10/2018 at 2:44am officers were dispatched to 3830 W. National Av for a battery complaint. The investigation revealed a fight occurred between two male patrons, who were fighting over a female patron. ESTRADA stated the employees no longer work at the bar, and he has brought back security on the weekends. He also stated he will fix the cameras so they record and will look into enrolling in the Pivot Program.
8. On 05/16/2018 officers were dispatched to Milwaukee Nights Pub, 3830 W. National Av, for a battery complaint. The officers located the victim who stated he was stabbed in the hand at the tavern. The officers interviewed the applicant and several witnesses who stated the subject was being disorderly and fell while walking out the door. The officer stated the injury was consistent with a fall. Steven ESTRADA stated there are no functional cameras at the location.
9. On 06/03/2018 at 2:08am officers were dispatched to Milwaukee Nights Pub, 3830 W. National Av, for a battery complaint. The officer spoke with the security guard, Raul PEREZ, who stated there were two large groups in the bar. A female from one group threw a drink on some one. In order to prevent a fight PEREZ put the female out of the bar and locked the door, preventing anyone from leaving until the female was gone. The officer did not observe anyone that was injured.

Amber stated the physical fight continued from the North end of the bar to the South East corner of the bar. Amber stated the two subject fell onto the ground and continued to physically fight. Amber stated during the fight, one subject, unknown if top or bottom subject, pulled a firearm and shot. Amber stated the crowd of people then grabbed the victim, identified as Joshua J. THOMAS, m/b, 9-27-1994, portion of the fight and dragged him to the North end of the bar and the suspect fled in an unknown direction.

Joshua suffered a gun shot wound to his left upper side, which is not life threatening. A 9mm casing was recovered from inside the tavern in the South East corner.

I spoke with the owner, Samona, who arrived on scene after the incident. Samona stated she does not need security during the day and said, "I can't control everything like that" and at first, appeared hostile while Sgt. MARTIN was explaining all of the possible violations within the business.

I attempted to have Samona access the camera system, which Samona stated the camera system does not record unless the door opens or there is a security risk, ie: break in.

Samona stated she rented out the business for \$150.00 to a group that she only knew from Facebook. Samona did not have a contract with them and did not know their legal names.

Samona was cooperative with detectives during their investigation.

The basement area was checked and officers observed standing water inside the basement.

Prosecution Unit. On Thursday, March 7, 2019, at 3:00 PM, LT. Elizabeth IBARRA, SGT. Chad RADEN, P.O. Oscar PICENO, P.O. Benjamin SPITZER, P.O. Mariolys FLORES, A.C.A. Heather HOUGH, and I met with the licensee of Milwaukee Nights Pub, LLC, Samona MCCANN, at District Two to discuss the recent shooting incident that occurred at her tavern and events surrounding the incident.

The meeting began with a recap of the incident from the license premises report. Areas of concern from the report were; smoking (marijuana) in the public and employee areas of the tavern, one employee working with approximately forty (40) patrons inside of the premises, security cameras that were not recording, no security guard at the premises, liquor bottles possibly not purchased from a distributor, food sales without a permit, and that the event stemmed from "rap battle" which is not included in the premises' Public Entertainment permit.

MCCANN stated that she had attended rap battles at other taverns where no incidents occurred and no security was present. MCCANN stated that she allowed the group to host the battle at her tavern in exchange for a \$150.00 cleaning fee. MCCANN stated that she left prior to the incident and that shortly after she left the group put up signs for the food sales and one of her employees also left, leaving one bartender. MCCANN stated that she always has security present on Saturday nights (the busiest night for the bar) after 10:00 PM.

SGT. RADEN discussed the use of promoters, the danger they potentially pose to a licensee, and how a licensee is ultimately responsible for actions done by a promoter inside of a licensed premises. IT should be noted that the license application indicates that promoters and sound amplification would NOT be used. SGT RADEN also discussed the selling or giving away of food and how a food dealer's license is required and inspections by the Health Department. SGT RADEN also discussed the use "DJs" which is also not a part of the premises' license. MCCANN contended that most of the time the "DJ" is just a subject playing music from an Iphone or Ipad. SGT RADEN and ACA HOUGH informed MCCANN that if the subject is not an employee, is featured or advertised as a DJ, is using a sound amplifier, and is not simply playing music in the background then the subject should be considered as a "DJ".

I then reviewed several Face Book postings for the tavern that included the advertisement for DJs, food, and hookahs. MCCANN stated that she had created the posts and would remove items or posts that were not allowed by her license and that she would seek special event permits for St. Patrick's Day and for opening day of the Milwaukee Brewer's season.

MCCANN stated that after the shooting she had already implemented the following changes:

I advised her to tell her security guard to pat down patrons for weapons and check purses and if a patron leaves the tavern and returned to check them again. I also explained to them it was safer if they just use the front entrance door and not permit people use the side door, only for emergencies. McCann and ESTRADA agreed.

McCann and ESTRADA showed us there new surveillance cameras and the footage streams directly to his phones. McCann and ESTRADA stated in case of an incident they will be able to show us surveillance footage.

I didn't observe any other violations and the owners where cooperative.
