

Ordinance relating to the First Amendment to a Detailed Planned Development (DPD) known as Cameo Care Campus, located on the East Side of South 27th Street and North of West Goldcrest Avenue, in the 13th Aldermanic District (DCD)

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee ("Common Coun-cil"), do ordain as follows:

Part 1. There is added to the Milwau-kee Code of Ordinances ("Code") a new section to read as follows: Section 295-907(2)(b) 0065

(1) In accordance with the provisions of Section 295-907(2) of the Code relating to the procedures and establishment of planned development districts, ment of planned development districts, the Common Council approves the subject amended Detailed Planned Development, a copy of which is attached to this Common Council File as Exhibit A which is on file in the office of the City Clerk and made a part as though fully

Clerk and made a part as though fully set forth herein.

(2) The zoning map is amended to change the zoning for platted lands all being a redivision of Parcels 1, 2 and 3 of Certified Survey Map No. 6177, being in the Southwest 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 31, Township of North, Range 22 East, in the City of Milwaukee, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin now being more particularly bounded and described as follows:

The Common Council declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion irre-spective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases or other portions be declared void or invalid.
