REASON FOR REQUEST:

Andrew Bell, a City of Milwaukee police officer, was in the scope of his employment and operating a City of Milwaukee police vehicle that was traveling eastbound on West Villard Avenue. As the City vehicle entered the intersection of North 37th Street and West Villard Avenue, the uninsured motorist, who was intoxicated and traveling southbound on North 37th Street, failed to yield the right away by disregarding the red traffic signal, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Officer Bell sustained injuries to his head, neck and ribs. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$12,658.21.
