ADDITIONAL COMMENTS/RECOMMENDATIONS:

This report is written by Police Officer Michael WARD, assigned to District 6, Early Power Shift, Community Liaison and Community Prosecution Office, with P.O. Fabian GARCIA.

On Wednesday, December 16th, 2020, we conducted a CPTED Survey at 2758 S. 35th St., WI 53215.

Owner and Listed Agent, Daniel Mora-Sanchez (M/W, 08-03-1982) was on scene during the CPTED survey. Currently the location is still under renovations.

Mora-Sanchez state he will be purchasing a new security system for the tavern. Mora-Sanchez stated he will have 5 cameras locate on the interior and 3 located on exterior of the building. Mora-Sanchez was advised that one camera should be placed near the front entrance (interior) to capture customers entering and exiting. Mora-Sanchez was also advised one camera in the parking lot would be highly recommended.

The parking lot is located in the rear of the building and you gain access to the lot through the alley way. The sight line from the parking lot to the tavern is blocked by a 6' privacy fence that is in place for an enclosed back patio. No lighting for the back parking lot except for the lights mounted for alley way lighting. Lighting was not observed during the hours of darkness.

Mora-Sanchez was advised to keep windows free of signage for clean sight lines in and out of the tayern.

Mora-Sanchez stated he will hire contracted security for the tavern and have them work during peak times of operation. Mora-Sanchez stated he would have security patrol the parking as well.

Mora-Sanchez will be adding an office and locker space in the basement of the location. The basement will also be used as a storage area.

Mora- Sanchez was given contact numbers for District 6 office, Non-Emergency, and the CPU Office.


