

Title

An ordinance granting a subterranean space lease to Renaissance Lafayette LLC for a subsurface soil stabilization facility in the public right-of-way on East Lafayette Place from the east curb line of North Prospect Avenue for 144.26 feet to the east thereof in the 3rd Aldermanic District.

Analysis

Adoption of this ordinance will allow the granting and execution of a subterranean space lease between the City and Renaissance Lafayette LLC for installation of soil nails as part of a subsurface soil stabilization facility in the public right-of-way along East Lafayette Place from the east curb line of North Prospect Avenue to a point 144.26 feet to the east in connection with the development of two twenty-story condominium towers and other improvements for a Detailed Plan Development District known as Renaissance's Park Lafayette under Common Council File No. 050580 in the 3rd Aldermanic District.
