Wooden fence/gate to enclose side yard. Fence will be installed roughly in line with the front wall of the house. Owner is responsible for veryifying property lines. Gate must not attach to the neighbor's house.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 320-21 (11) and (12) of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances, the Milwaukee Historic Preservation Commission has issued a certificate of appropriateness for the work listed above. The work was found to be consistent with preservation guidelines. The following conditions apply to this certificate of appropriateness:

All wood must be smooth and equivalent to #1 grade cedar or better for use in rear and side yards. Sections of fence forward of or in line with the primary building's front setback must be clear grain. Wood fences must be painted or stained upon completion. Note: when new, bare wood is left exposed to the exterior elements for a period of only a week or two, the life of the finish subsequently applied to it will be decreased.

All work must be done in a craftsman-like manner, and must be completed within one year of the date this certificate was issued. Staff must approve any changes or additions to this certificate before work begins. Work that is not completed in accordance with this certificate may be subject to correction orders or citations.
