File # 020262 is a resolution relative to application, acceptance and funding of the Medical Assistance Outreach Grant.

### **Background**

- 1. This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Health Department (MHD) to apply for, accept and fund the Medical Assistance Outreach Grant from the Annie E. Casey Foundation.
- 2. This is a new grant.

### **Discussion**

- 1. The purpose of this grant is to assist low-income families in obtaining health insurance and food stamps.
- 2. This grant will also support outreach efforts in 13 census tracts in Milwaukee; an area bounded by West Center Street, North 24<sup>th</sup> Street, West Highland Boulevard and North 47<sup>th</sup> Street. This neighborhood has been designated as the *Making Connections* area by MHD. This area has been identified as having a significant concentration of daycare centers in zip codes with lower income residents.
- 3. This target area, populated by approximately 27,000 people, will be canvassed in order to measure the impact of MHD programs and services including immunizations, lead screening and Well Woman initiatives.
- 4. *Making Connections* will serve to provide educational outreach services for the purpose of "connecting" eligible residents with health, social and related services available to them.
- 5. Through this outreach program, MHD will measure the impact of its services on the economic, environmental and social issues specific to this neighborhood.
- 6. This grant encompasses the period of January 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002.

#### Fiscal Impact

1. The total amount of this grant is \$30,000, entirely from the grantor.

2. This grant will fund 50% of the existing MHD Medical Assistance Outreach Supervisor position.
