Subject: Falcon Bowl license renewal

To whom it may concern,

I'm writing to ask about the public hearing tomorrow (Wednesday, Feb 18, 2026) for the license renewal for Falcon Bowl at 801 East Clarke.

I live [redacted] and have spoken to the sound engineer and one of the owners about noise concerns. We've been regularly disturbed by noise at random hours, including midday noise that shook my home. Last week, there was loud music that went as late as 1:40am. I was informed by the sound engineer that he projects sound louder at Falcon than at other music venues. The owner told me that he chose to do this because the venue is not adequately sound proofed because it's intended for acoustic music. They amp the music up louder since they "lose sound." This sound travels to the families in the neighborhood. I have not filed an official noise complaint with the police but I know at least one neighbor has.

I feel that the owners ought to cease playing music that loudly until they've made the proper renovations to the building. The health and wellness of the community does not seem to be a priority here. We are a residential area with children and working families, including veterans and folks with noise sensitivities.

I'm not sure if this email is too late to be considered in the hearing. This issue is ongoing and I will take other action to resolve it, if need. I did not receive the notice of the hearing until a few days ago.
