

Crime Prevention

Firearm Recovery by SROs

School Resource Officers recovered multiple firearms from students aged 8 to 17, enhancing campus safety.

Student reports about firearms on school grounds triggered immediate responses from administrators and officers.

Deescalating Conflicts

SROs actively respond to fights and disturbances, particularly during lunch and dismissal, to ensure safety.



EARLY INTERVENTION & COMMUNITY RESOURCES

- **Proactive Issue Identification**
- SROs are trained to spot potential problems early to prevent escalation into serious incidents.
- **Community Resource Partnerships**
- OCWS and 414 LIFE to support student well-being.
- **Violence Prevention and Support**
- Partnerships focus on preventing violence and addressing bullying, substance abuse, and mental health.




MENTORSHIP & POSITIVE ENGAGEMENT

- **Interactive Q&A Sessions**
- The '12 with 12' series offers students monthly Q&A opportunities with officers on safety and decision-making topics.
- **Weekly Engagement and Coaching**
- SROs conduct weekly reports and coaching sessions with 9th graders to encourage leadership and community involvement.
- **Community Resource Introduction**
- Students are introduced to local nonprofits promoting growth and engagement, fostering positive community connections.
