The Sign Cabinet and 2" x 2" Brackets are Painted with Matthews Polyurethane MAPP N923SP Black. And then covered with Pricfed and Mathe Laminated Graphics.

Top Mount Attachment Hardware on Sign Cabinet for guy wires, chain, or rod supports.
