Dear Ms. King:

This office is in receipt of your claim in the amount of \$4,214.25, relating to damage sustained to your property on May 14, 2002 when a water pipe was broken causing water in the basement of you unit at 411 West Keefe Avenue.

The Department of City Development (DCD) records indicate the tenant in the upper unit while mopping the bathroom, bumped and broke a pipe behind the toilet causing water to run into your unit. The maintenance contractor for DCD was contacted. The running water was stopped and the broken pipe was fixed. After the repairs, your unit was inspected, there was no visible damage. The DCD staff checked with the maintenance contractor, they indicated the amount of water that ran into the basement could not have caused the claimed damage. The Department of City Development was not negligent with respect to their response time, manner of repairs or attempts to minimize consequential damages and therefore the City cannot accept liability for this loss. Accordingly, we are denying your claim.
