Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Molly Kuether-Steele at (414) 286-2775 or molly.kuether-steele@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

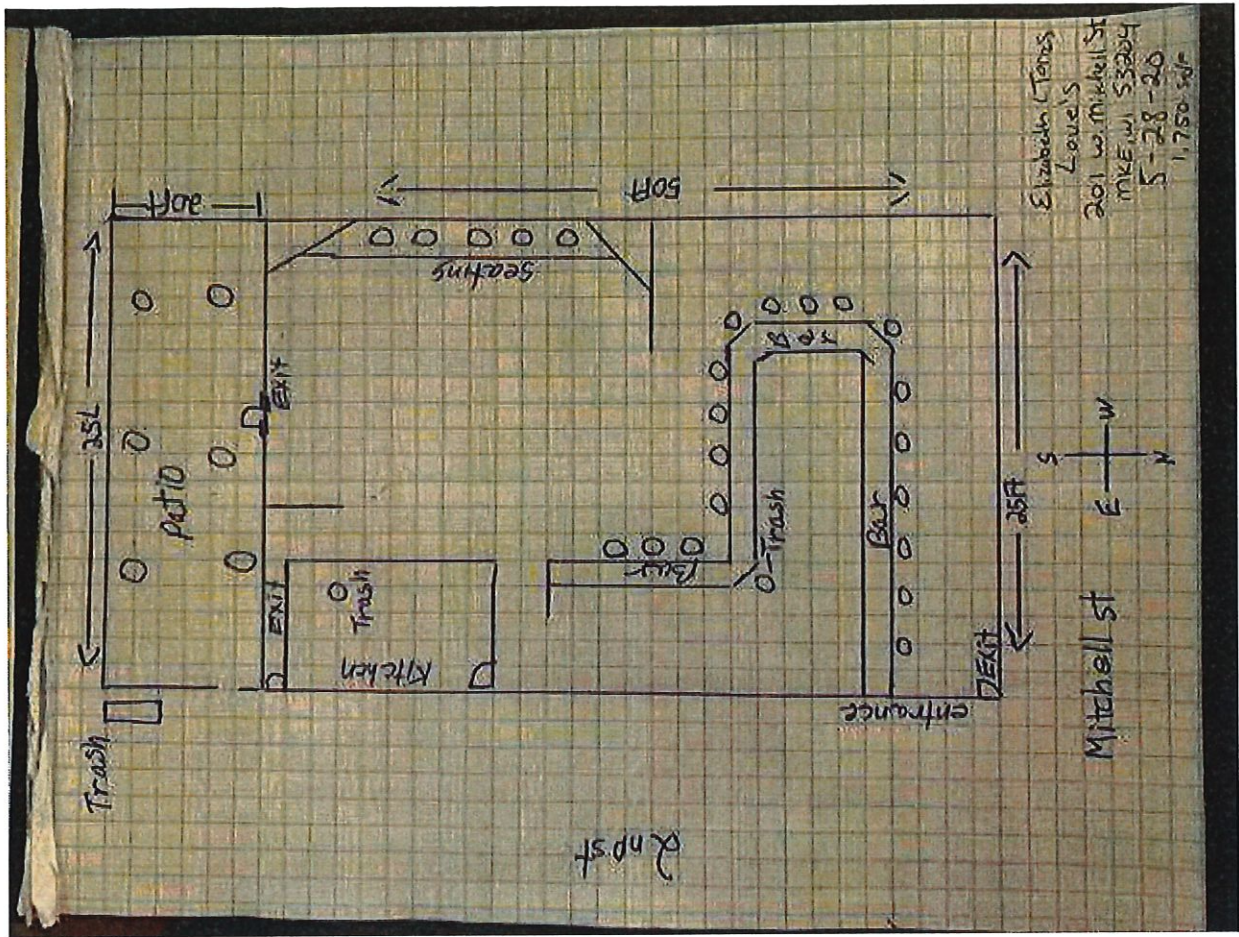

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

This report is written by Police Officer David NOVAK, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 01/20/07 at 10:46 pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 4301 S Howell Avenue for an Armed Robbery complaint. Investigation revealed that unknown actors entered the open business, displayed a handgun, demanded and obtained property without consent. No one was injured in this incident.
2. On 06/17/09 at 10:50 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 4301 S Howell Avenue for a Battery complaint. Officers spoke to the victim who stated she and some friends were at Changes when words were exchanged between her and another patron. The victim stated that this patron then slapped her in the face three times. Police spoke with witnesses who stated they observed a verbal argument between the two but no physical contact. Both patrons were cited for disorderly conduct.
3. On 11/13/2010 at approximately 10:07am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 4301 S Howell Av for a Theft. Investigation revealed a theft occurred in the basement office area of \$3,414.00 in cash from a desk drawer.

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5. On 03/17/2017 officers responded to Off the Clock Bar and Grill, 4301 S Howell Av, for a trouble with subject. The officers spoke with the manager, Ravelle GARCIA, who stated there was an employee who had been drinking all day during her shift. She was asked to leave and refused. Only after advising that the police were called did the employee leave. The applicant was on scene and was cooperative.

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6. On 06/26/2019 at 10:08pm officers were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject at On the Clock, 4301 S Howell Av. The server was the caller and stated that a table used a Groupon and did not want to pay the full bill. She stated that a gratuity was automatically added and the table refused to pay it. The officer contacted the customer who stated they were never notified there was an automatic gratuity and they were not happy with the service so they did not pay the tip. The officer then checked with Groupon and it did not advise of the automatic gratuity. The server was advised and she stated she did not want to pursue the matter.
7. On 03/19/2020 officers were dispatched to a Tavern violation at On the Clock, 4301 S Howell Av. The caller stated there were people inside drinking in violation of the governor's emergency order. When the officer arrived he observed two people sitting at the bar with alcoholic drinks. The applicant was on scene and stated they were employees who just got off shift. He was advised that no one could be inside consuming food or drinks. The applicant was cooperative and stated he understood the order.

This report is being written by P.O. Christopher JACKSON assigned to District Six, Late Power Shift.

On Wednesday, June 26, 2019 I was assigned to Squad 6468, License Premise Unit. At approximately 10:08pm Squad 6440, P.O. William DEL MORAL and P.O. Shawn SWITZER were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject complaint at On The Clock Bar/Restaurant (4301 S. Howell Av. in the City of Milwaukee).

I assisted in this call for service and spoke with the caller Jessica A. BARNARD (F/W 06-01-00) over the phone before squad arrival. BARNARD explained to me that she serviced a table that included 4 subjects 1 female and 3 males. As she placed the bill on the table they stated that they wanted to split the bill two ways. When the bill was split BARNARD stated that the subjects attempted to use the same groupon for a discount toward each bill. The customers began to get upset, argue with her and complain about the service. The total was then placed back on one bill to apply the groupon's discount. The total was \$106.78 including the sales taxes. It also included a 20% gratuity with an added price of \$27.35. The table left the exact amount of \$106.78 on the table and did not pay the 20% gratuity added on. BARNARD stated that as the subjects left she managed to get a plate #AFP-7059. She also stated that the groupon automatically adds the 20% gratuity onto the bill. BARNARD expressed the want to charge the individuals related to this incident for her loss of funds.

I informed BARNARD that I would currently have to follow up regarding this incident at a later date to make contact with subjects and research the groupon.

On Saturday, June 29, 2019 I conducted follow up at 4510 W. Howard Av. in the City of Milwaukee. I spoke with Andres M. GUILLAMA (W/M 01-29-74) and his wife via a phone regarding the situation at the above location. GUILLAMA stated that they did not like the service they were receiving at the location and wanted to pay and use a groupon discount. He then

stated that he paid the exact amount for their food and drinks but refused to pay a tip or gratuity due to the service. GUILLAMA stated that the groupon does not state that the gratuity will be neither added nor mandatory. He also stated that the server did not either.

The groupon was researched by me and LIU Sgt. Chad RADEN which did not list that a mandatory 20% gratuity will be added to the bill. It did list that only one coupon per table and the discount is not valid on alcohol purchases.

After collecting further information I contacted BARNARD regarding. I informed her based on the information I collected that the individuals involved in this incident were not properly notified prior to using the groupon that a mandatory 20% gratuity will be added to the bill before the discount is even applied. BARNARD stated that she understood and did not wish to go any further regarding the incident.

It should be noted that I conducted a license premise check of the business on June 2, 2019. During this check I was able to observe that as you walk into the business there is printed piece of paper that stated a 20% gratuity will be added to groupon users. The issue I believe to be with this sign is that its printed on regular printing paper and placed in a position that could be over looked or missed completely. The only other related posting is located inside the business but positioned around a corner that would not have been seen by the subjects involved. I also spoke with a bartender, who was also working the night of the incident that stated their own employees could do a better job at explaining that the gratuity is added if they use the groupon. The bartender did state that she would contact the owner and inform him of the incident and concerns regarding the groupon.

INITIAL INVESTIGATION

This report is written by P.O. Joshua YANG, assigned to District Six, Late Power Shift. On Thursday, March 19, 2020, I was assigned to the License Premise squad (Squad 6468) with P.O. Joel BUNKELMAN.

At approximately 7:28 pm, P.O. BUNKELMAN and I were dispatched to a tavern violation at 4301 S. Howell Ave. (On The Clock, Tavern license# 0207461). Squad 6246, P.O. Bradley JOHNSON also responded to this assignment. An anonymous female caller had called and stated that there were 20 people in the bar, claiming carry out but there are people drinking inside.

Upon arrival, I parked our squad car immediately in front of the location and walked inside using the north entrance. I observed that there was an older male subject standing behind the bar along with a male and female subject that were sitting at the bar. I observed that further down the bar there was another male subject that was sitting at the bar but did not have a drink in front of him and I was advised that this subject was waiting for a to-go order of food. I observed that the male sitting at the bar had a mixed drink in front of him and the female subject had an open bottle of beer in front of her. The older male subject standing behind the bar was later identified as **Robert J. KRAUSE (W/M, 8/6/49)** and was the owner/agent.

While speaking with KRAUSE, the male subject that was sitting at the bar waiting for the to-go order obtained his food and left the location.

KRAUSE stated that the male and female subject sitting at the bar were employees who had just finished their shift. KRAUSE was advised that according to Emergency Food Order #5, no food or beverage may be consumed inside the restaurant. KRAUSE stated that he thought it was okay for his employees to get a drink after their shift and didn't think anything was wrong with it. KRAUSE was advised that in Line 11 sub a. no seating may be provided and food may not be consumed. KRAUSE understood the guidelines when it was explained to him.

KRAUSE has been extremely cooperative in the past and was again during this encounter. KRAUSE was given a copy of Emergency Order number #5 along with a PF-06.


