Allocation Purpose:

The 2024 Southeast Wisconsin Threat Analysis Center (STAC) Operations grant will provide funding to continue support of the STAC, an all crimes, all threats, information sharing fusion center that serves the eight counties of Southeast Wisconsin including Milwaukee, Waukesha, Racine, Kenosha, Walworth, Ozaukee, Washington and Dodge. Funds will enhance STAC capabilities with purchases for technology software, equipment upgrades, supplies, and staff training to maintain STAC's certifications. The 2023 grant was extended through March, 2024 due to staffing constraints with the State grant office. Therefore, the 2024 grant began in April.

Program Goals:

The mission of the STAC is to gather, receive, analyze, and disseminate information and intelligence to various public and private agency partners. The STAC Operations grant will assist with enhancing collaboration, increasing information sharing, and expanding state and local efforts to identify threats and prevent terrorism and other catastrophic events.

Programmatic Summary:

The Milwaukee Police Department is the host agency for the Southeast Wisconsin Threat Analysis Center (STAC) and funding will support STAC training, equipment, supplies, and technology in order to ensure continuity of operations.
