He had broken the pipe and the water was spraying all over the floor this is why he would have to shut the water off at the main street line. Once he turned that off and got the meter off he told me he would be back with the part that he broke he was going to take it back to the shop to make repairs. Dear Sir or Madam:

We have received your claim regarding the leak on your lead water service lateral occurring before or during the process of exchanging the water meter at 3232 West Fond du Lac Avenue on November 1, 2023.

Our investigation reveals that on November 1, 2023, Milwaukee Water Works(MWW) field staff was assigned to exchange the water meter at the subject property. During the course of turning off the water, the inlet lead pipe began to leak. MWW took responsibility for repairing the leak, however, the owner was notified of their responsibility to replace the lead service line with a copper line.

This repair to the water service line required the property be placed in the Lead Service Line Replacement Program subject to the City of Milwaukee Code of Ordinances, s. 225-25.5-3-a, which states, "a service line must be replaced when a leak or failure has been discovered on either the privately owned or utility owned portion of the service line." There is no clause in the ordinance which allows for costs associated with the private side of the Lead Service Line Replacement Program to be waived.

It is our position that the City is not liable for damages. As such, we are denying your claim.
