As part of a continuing plan to convert one-hour meter parking to two-hour meter parking, we are introducing meter parking time restriction changes within your district. We are recommending the following changes:

- Both sides of North Plankinton Avenue from West Wells Street to West Kilbourn Avenue
- The west side of North Plankinton Avenue from West Wisconsin Avenue to West Wells Street
- Both sides of North 2nd Street from West Wisconsin Avenue to West Wells Street
- The west side of North 2nd Street from West Plankinton Avenue to West Wells Street
- Both sides of North Old World Third Street from West Wisconsin Avenue to West Kilbourn Avenue
- Both sides of North 4th Street from West Wisconsin Avenue to West Kilbourn Avenue
- The north side of West Wells Street from North 2nd Street to North 4th Street





This is in response to a request we received from Ms. S. Virginia Honish, principal of Divine Savior Holy Angels High School to install the above-captioned parking restriction.

Our traffic engineering staff has investigated this request and found that motorists exiting the High School's driveways have a difficult time seeing traffic traveling southbound on North 100th Street when vehicles park close to their driveways. Therefore, in the interest of public safety, we recommend installing this restriction to increase motorists' visibility of southbound traffic.


