On Saturday, September 7, 2019, I was assigned to work Wisconsin WINS Youth Tobacco Initiative, which checks area vendors for age compliant tobacco sales. Assisting in this assignment was: Carlos NMN VILLAVALADEZ (m/w 05-30-03 of 2719 W. Cherry St). VILLAVALADEZ is 16 years old and not of legal age to purchase tobacco.

At approximately 10:37 AM VILLAVALADEZ entered Marathon Mini Mart, located at 4312 W. Fond Du Lac Ave., and purchased a flavored, Mango Swisher Sweet Cigar. VILLAVALADEZ stated the cashier did check his ID and was described as: a male, middle eastern, wearing a white shirt, with glass, and a black baseball hat. Upon entering the store I was able to immediately identify the cashier based on the description provided. The cashier was identified as: Bahadur S. BOPARAI (m/w 01-28-63), who is also the agent. BOPARAI admitted to the sale and apologized. I explained I would be issuing a citation for the violation in the mail.

- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

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

- 2:11 am: The suspect leaves out the north side entry door along and walks through MJ'S Lounge parking lot onto the public sidewalk. The sidewalk is just west of the north side entry door.
- 2:12 am: The suspect walks paces back and forth on the public sidewalk between MJ'S north and south parking lot entrance/exit.
- 2:12 am: The suspect is approached by a black male described as heavy build wearing all black clothing. The black male swings and misses at suspect. The suspect retreats and pulls out a firearm from his waist area and discharges it while running towards the black male. (The black male description: B/M, dark complexion wearing dark clothing.)
- 2:13 am: The video does not show who shoots back at the suspect. The suspect retreats by running
 west bound from the 4600 Block of West Fond Du Lac Ave between the gang way of 4703 and
 4713 W. Fond Du Lac Ave out of video site.

6. On 05/24/2018 officers, along with an agent from the WI Department of Revenue, conducted a licensed premises check on S&S Liquor at 3200 N. 27th St. Upon entering the officer observed the clerk, Antowon ROBY, reaching under the counter by the register. When the officer checked the area he found packaged marijuana. The clerk was arrested. Additional marijuana was found in a case of alcohol next to the stairwell leading to the basement. The Department of Revenue agent found cigarettes with improper tax stamps and liquor that was in violation of State Statues. The applicant arrived and stated he did not know his employee was selling narcotics.

- 7. On 05/31/2018 a meeting was held at District 5 regarding S&S Liquor, 3200 N. 27th St. The officer made recommendations to the applicant regarding cameras, lighting, no loitering signs, replacing windows with glass block and moving the garbage cans. The applicant was asked about loitering outside the business and he stated he didn't think it was a problem. The applicant stated he would begin working on the recommendations.
- 8. On 07/08/2018 officers attempted a controlled buy of narcotics at S&S Liquor, 3200 N. 27th St, with the help of a Confidential Informant (CI). The CI went in the store and asked the clerk, Antowon ROBY, if there was marijuana available in the store. ROBY informed the CI there was not but directed him to a subject outside. The CI was able to buy marijuana from the subject outside and turned it over to the officers.

- 9. On 07/10/2018 officers attempted a controlled buy of narcotics at S&S Liquor, 3200 N. 27th St, with the help of a Confidential Informant (CI). The CI went in the store and asked the clerk, Antowon ROBY, if there was marijuana available in the store. ROBY informed the CI there was not but directed him to a subject outside. The CI was flagged down by a subjects standing at 2618 W. Auer Ave and was able to buy marijuana from one of the subjects. The CI turned the marijuana over to the officers. The officers then arrested the subjects and recovered additional marijuana.
- 10. On 07/18/2018 at 6:04pm an officer was flagged down at 3200 N. 27th St for a battery. The victim stated he was in the store to purchase alcohol and got into an argument with a known female. The female left and a short time later her son came to the store and struck the victim to the face. The victim lost two teeth as a result of the incident. The officers spoke with the employee who was cooperative but the owner walked away from the officers when they attempted to speak to him. Video of the incident was recovered.
- 11. On 09/23/2018 officers observed a subject exiting the store at 3200 N. 27th St with alcohol after the liquor license was suspended on 09/20/2019. The officers conducted a licensed premise check and spoke with an employee who stated the store had a Temporary Restraining Order allowing them to sell alcohol.
- 12.On 01/27/2019 officers conducted a licensed premise check at 3200 N. 27th St. the officers observed the licenses were expired and spoke with the owner, who stated he had a court case pending and he could stay open until the case was completed. The officers confirmed the information provided by the owner and allowed him to remain open.
