

- Identify challenges and inefficiencies, working closely with departments to recommend, implement and test solutions

2024 - Targeted Financial Quick Wins

- ➤ Are legal in Wisconsin
- ➤ Represents sound public policy & potential revenue enhancer
- ➤ State law does not currently have an applicable "owner's liability provision"
- ➤ Back to a state lobbying target...

Potential Innovation Programs in Exploration/Discussion Phase

Supplementing City FastCare Clinic Sites?

- McKinley Health Center
- Meijer FastCare Centers Currently in Greenfield, Sussex and West Bend
- Looking for functional added Milwaukee City or County sites

City Employee Home Down Payment Advance Program?

- Encourages home ownership in city
- Fund with 3% City resident incentive
- Would Supplement Home Down Payment Assistance Program for income eligible employees
 - \$5,000 or \$7,000 eligible down payment

2024-25 Innovation "Group" Projects

- Data Advancement Working Group
- City Facilities Plan Team
 - City Hall Campus, Valley properties, Century City, fire repair facility focus
- City Cross Departmental Policy Teams
 - E.g., Vision Zero, business improvement
- FPC /MPD Police Recruitment & Retention Working Group
 - Address recruitment challenges & potential MOE shared revenue penalty
 - Lateral bonuses, Intergovernmental recruitment bonus, marketing, web site & social media firm RFI proposal, mandatory exit interviews, and private background investigations to speed recruitment process
- GMC Task Intergovernmental & Advocacy Task Forces
- UW-LaFollette School Capstone Projects for FPC & DPW
 - Recruitment & Retention Enhancement for Police/ Emergency Management Service Optimization

Projects Stemming from Outstanding Receivables

Outstanding Unpaid Parking Citation

- Represents \$41m in outstanding citations & \$16m plus for 5 or more outstanding citations
- Enabling legislation adoption creating enforcement would yield est. \$2.5m from outstanding revenues w/ greater law adherence and tix payment
- Pursuing legislative policy around Habitual Parking Violators

Private Towing Companies

- Represents ~\$500k in outstanding receivables
- Licensing timing change with DPW administrative change
- DPW maximize statutory towing administrative fee encouraged increase from \$30 to \$35.

Chapter 98 Reforms/Conduit Revenue

- Represents \$5m in outstanding receivables
 - 2 firms (Unity & Windstream) made back payments totaling \$343,000
- 10% revenue and penalty enhancer & future inflationary adjustments and interest penalty
- Process improvement for non-payment referrals & accountability around permitting

Intergovernmental Cooperation

State Innovation Fund Grant Challenges

- DOR late in establishing rules; timing inflexibility of July
 10% savings + inflation over 3-years.
 Signed agreement must be timed from Nov. 13, 2024 to July 2025
 Agreement must be a minimum of 6 years
- Rigidly applies to wholesale transfer of services & not shared agreements
 - E.G.- MFD maintenance agreements not eligible as they do not transfer a service. MRF would not have been eligible.
- Wauwatosa LCR Workforce Tracker Software Deal
- Milwaukee County-City Discussions
 Variety of opportunities in housing, workforce health, mowing, small engines, nursery/green house operations, and fire equipment maintenance, etc. being discussed

Intergovernmental Cooperation, Part II

- Wisconsin Center District Pilot Revised Agreement
 - \$500,000 initial 2026 base payment w/ annual growing payments over remaining 35 years of the original deal
 - Nullifies problematic funding language tied to "net income"
 - Inflationary increases of 2.5% annually to expand on and grow base payment
 - 1% monthly interest after 90 days for late payments
 - Delivers \$27.5m over 35 years in guaranteed payments vs. the current PILOT which has paid \$0 for three year's running

Innovation in Intergovernmental Advocacy

Provide(d) Advocacy Around:

- Acceptance of City US DoJ Cops Grant application
- Police Recruitment Hiring Incentive Bonus Resolution
- MOE Federal Grants Exclusion Change
- MOE Flexibility Reform
- Red Light Running Flexibility/Speed Camera Legalization
- Water Workforce Training Partnership Earmark Request w/ Water Council, Veolia & MMSD

Technology, Data & Al Promotion

Initiated Civia GovAI Exploration & Trial

- Enterprise AI/LLM tool w/ integrated compliance and safety layers into the solution and searches contextualized w/ local government users and applications in mind
- No data access required & no retention. Folios with security features and ability to track use

GovAI has the ability to upload and create function-specific Custom Assistants that can reference source material for City or department-specific agentic workflows. Some Examples:

- A Milwaukee City Ordinance Assistant which can help City Staff answer questions on internal policies/ordinances
- An IT Security Assistant which understands the NIST framework and City IT Policies and can assist information teams
- A Contract Review Assistant that understands the context of City Contract terms/requirements and can assist legal teams with initial reviews of agreements

Technology, Data & Al Promotion, part II

- Exploring AI Website External Search Tool and Potential UCC AI IVR System (Voice Assistant)
 - Current website host integrated search engine isn't functional. Al explored option offers promise.
 - IVR being explored for integration of city databases to provide specific info for residents in a voice operated question "when is my next scheduled recycling day at this address"? or "where do I vote"?
 - Multi-lingual function provides options to residents not fluent in English or Spanish
- Introduced & Promoted City Joining GovAl Coalition
- Created Data & IT Tech Advancement Working Group
 - Address silos- citywide repository for resources, professional development, etc. and setting strategic roadmap
 - Systemic data governance to establish, educate & enforce standards and improve data info sharing across departments
 - Add tools to enhance ease and access of public data
 - Infuse uses of data in policy decision making
