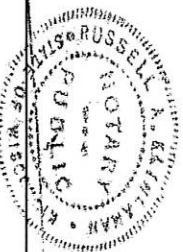

the City of Milwaukee adopted
preliminary resolutions, determining
it necessary and in the public
interest to construct and levy special
assessments for the following

1st Aldermanic District
N. 52nd St. - W. Villard Ave. to
W. Silver Spring Dr. (ST2111-
40109) File Number 120112:
Asphalt pavement resurfacing,
replace curb and gutter, sidewalk
and driveway approaches where
necessary, sodding (9-foot width of
tree border area), and grading.
(Assessable Reconstruction Paving
Fund -- \$95,000; Nonassessable
Reconstruction Paving Fund --
\$400,000). The total estimated cost
for this project including the
requested amount is \$530,000. This
project is anticipated to be
completed during the 2017 construc-
tion season.

11th Aldermanic District
Alley between W. Cleveland
Ave., W. Montana St., S. 49th St.,
and S. 50th St. (ST212060106) File
Number 091341: Concrete alley
pavement reconstruction, replace
some abutting walk or driveway
approaches, grading, storm drainage
facilities, and permeable pavement
as necessary. (Assessable Alley
Paving Fund -- \$52,000; Nonasses-
sable Alley Paving Fund -- \$40,000).
The total estimated cost for this
project including the requested
amount is \$190,000. This project is
anticipated to be completed during
the 2017 construction season.

(ST211170173): Install traffic
calming speed table. (Assessable
Reconstruction Paving Fund --
\$25,000; Nonassessable Recon-
struction Paving Fund -- \$25,000).
The total estimated cost for this
project including the requested
amount is \$50,000. This project is
anticipated to be completed during
the 2017 construction season.
