Dear Council Members:

We return the enclosed document which has been filed with the City Clerk and ask that it be introduced and referred to the Committee on Judiciary & Legislation with the following recommendation.

Claimant, Oriel Wilder, 1803 West Fairmount Avenue, Milwaukee, WI 53209 alleges that on May 14, 2004 he sustained damages when a City sewer backed-up into his basement. He claims damages in the amount of \$6,700.00.

Our investigation reveals that the Infrastructure Services Division records indicate that they investigated a backwater at 1803 West Fairmount Avenue on May 15, 2004 and found the Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District interceptor sewer to be surcharged on May 14, 2004 causing the City main sanitary sewer to back-up into the basement. Saturated ground conditions and sever rain that occurred on this date resulted in flows that exceeded the capacity of the system. As such, the City would not be liable. Therefore, we recommend that this claim be denied.
