
Dear Mr. Williams:


This office is in receipt of your claim in the amount of \$2,473.93, relating to the tow and recycling of your 1985 Buick and 1985 Olds on January 24, 2001.

We are advised by the Department of Neighborhood Services that on January 8, 2001 the vehicles were first observed and written notices were mailed to the property owner, Jonathan D. Duggan indicating the vehicles were considered a nuisance. The notices were not mailed to you because neither vehicle had license plates and the vehicle identification numbers were not visible. A re-inspection of the property was completed on January 16, 2001. The re-inspection revealed the vehicles were present and in the same condition. The vehicles were then referred for towing. The Department of Neighborhood services followed appropriate procedures in this matter, therefore, the City would not be liable. Accordingly, we are denying your claim.

If you wish to appeal this decision, you may do so by sending a letter within 21 days of the receipt of this letter to the Milwaukee City Clerk, 200 East Wells Street, Room 205, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53202, requesting a hearing.
