AMENDMENT TO COOPERATION AGREEMENT  
CONTRACT FOR RECEIPT AND FURNISHING  
OF SERVICES, MATERIALS AND EQUIPMENT  
BETWEEN

THE CITY OF MILWAUKEE THROUGH ITS VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS  
AND THE REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKEE

THIS AMENDMENT TO COOPERATION AGREEMENT ("Amendment") is entered into as of this 10<sup>th</sup> day of Sept., 2015 by and between the City of Milwaukee, a municipal body, created and existing under the laws of the state of Wisconsin (hereinafter referred to as the "CITY") and the Redevelopment Authority of the City of Milwaukee, a public body, corporate and politic, created and existing under the laws of the state of Wisconsin (hereinafter referred to as the "AUTHORITY").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, CITY and AUTHORITY entered into that certain Cooperation Agreement Contract for Receipt and Furnishing of Services, Materials and Equipment dated September 2, 2005 and effective as of January 1, 2000 (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 66.1333(15) the AUTHORITY's budget for each fiscal year shall be approved by the Common Council of the CITY; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to enter into this Amendment to conform the Agreement to the provisions of Wis. Stats. § 66.1333(15) and to provide for certain salary related provisions.

NOW, THEREFORE, In consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements contained herein, the parties hereto mutually agree as follows:

The Agreement is hereby amended by the addition of the following provisions:

1. Budget Approval. The AUTHORITY shall submit its annual budget to the Common Council for approval pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 66.1333(15), in a form substantially similar to CITY departmental budgets and concurrent with submission of the CITY budget to the Common Council. In accordance with Wis. Stats. § 66.1333(15) it is acknowledged that the Common Council may

alter or modify any item of the AUTHORITY's budget relating to salaries, office operation or facilities.

2. Classification Review. Prior to the AUTHORITY'S submission of its 2016 annual budget to the Finance and Personnel Committee, the CITY'S Department of Employee Relations shall perform a review of all AUTHORITY current vacant and filled positions to determine the appropriate classifications and corresponding pay ranges and communicate its findings to the Finance and Personnel Committee.

3. Application of CITY'S Salary Ordinance and Positions Ordinance. AUTHORITY. The CITY and the AUTHORITY agree that all current and future offices and positions within the AUTHORITY shall be governed by the CITY'S Positions Ordinance and Salary Ordinance and any applicable ordinances set forth in Milwaukee Code of Ordinances Ch. 350.

4. Effect. All terms and conditions of the Agreement are incorporated herein and are hereby modified to conform herewith, but in all other respects are to be and shall continue in full force and effect.
