Subject: Common Council Resolution File Number 060003

Dear Honorable Members:

Returned herewith is Common Council Resolution File 060003, being a petition from Forest County Potawatomi Community of Wisconsin to amend a special privilege to construct and maintain conduit under and across West Potawatomi Circle for the premises at 1721 West Canal Street.

The applicant had previously requested permission to construct and maintain four, 2-inch diameter conduit crossing under South 19th Street, south of West Potawatomi Circle, to carry power from a parking structure to a parking lot. Permission for these conduits was granted in 2005 under Common Council Resolution File Number 041239.

The present request is to construct and maintain four, 4-inch diameter conduit under and across West Potawatomi Circle to provide security and surveillance services to facilities south of West Potawatomi Circle. The new conduit package will commence at the westline of South 19th Street at a point approximately 38 feet north of the northline of West Potawatomi Circle and will extend 47 feet to the south where it turns to the southeast for 80 feet ending at the eastline of South 19th Street at a point 5 feet south of the southline of West Potawatomi Circle.

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We are not aware that the presence of the aforementioned underground conduits will have an adverse effect on the general use of the public right-of-way. We have, therefore, prepared the attached special privilege resolution, which, if adopted, will allow said underground conduits to occupy the public right-of-way.
