JANUARY 8, 2009

File #081173 authorizes the Milwaukee Police Department to apply for, accept and fund an Advanced Training Grant from the Wisconsin Department of Justice - Training and Standards Bureau, in the amount of \$22,500. Proceeds will be used to hold a course titled “Strategic Police Leadership, Team Leadership for Progressive Policing and High Impact Police Leadership.”

BACKGROUND

The Wisconsin Department of Justice - Training and Standards Bureau makes funds available to law enforcement agencies for initiatives to improve law enforcement training on a continuing basis.

Advanced Training Grants allow the Milwaukee Police Department to provide continuing education for law enforcement officers in the City of Milwaukee. This continuing education is proffered to enhance the skills of MPD officers, enabling them to more effectively and efficiently protect the public and reduce crime in the City.

DISCUSSION

This Advanced Training Grant will be used to hold a course titled “Strategic Police Leadership, Team Leadership for Progressive Policing and High Impact Police Leadership.” The \$22,500 in grant proceeds will be used for various instructional service costs and instructional materials as needed to teach the course.

This earmark grant encompasses the period October 1, 2008 to June 30, 2009 and is 100% grantor funded.

FISCAL IMPACT

This grant requires no City financial participation and has no impact on the tax levy.
