
REASON FOR REQUEST:

Kevin Bolyard, a City of Milwaukee police officer, was in the scope of his employment and on an MPD bicycle while attempting to conduct a field interview near the intersection of South 17th Street and West Greenfield Avenue. The uninsured motorist, Joseph Rivera, attempted to flee the scene and struck Officer Bolyard and the department bicycle, causing him to land on the hood of the uninsured vehicle and fall to the ground. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Officer Bolyard sustained injuries to his left knee, left hip, low back, and chest. The treating surgeon performed an L4-L5 fusion and indicated that the back injury is permanent. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$183,584.41.
