This causes many southbound vehicles to turn left from the right lane, which is unsafe and illegal under the existing lane pattern. Therefore, to clearly define traffic flow to reduce congestion and increase safety for southbound left-turning vehicles on North 34th Street at West Capitol Drive, signing and pavement markings will be installed to allow left turns from the right lane.
