On Friday, October 9, 2015, I jumped in cab 490 a little after 6 pm to take a ride from the airport to the Psifiter Hotel. I believe the driver's name was Mohammad. He asked me why I was in town and I told him that it was to see my boyfriend play basketball against the Bucks.

The standard cab ride from the airport to downtown should be no more than \$35. The driver continued to go in circles adding up their fare. I even pulled up the GPS on my phone and told him that he was going in circles. He told me that he knew what he was doing. I was intimidated by him after his tone of voice escalated when I told him that I saw the same landmark twice in the drive to the hotel. The cab drive added up to \$53. This was unheard of. He took advantage of me just because he assumed I had the funds to pay for it. He can't take advantage of a 22 year old female like that, be confrontational with.

When I got to the hotel, they made a complaint about the driver after seeing how much he charged me and told him that he is not allowed back there. But, I want to dispute the charge. I really need a refund back. At least a partial refund. I've been taken advantage of, treated poorly, and I'm disappointed.





One of the things we discussed over the phone was about what I would like to get out of this complaint. Most importantly, I would not want any sort of disciplinary action against the driver. I am sure he is going to be talked to, but I don't want any action to be taken against him. He was very nice and polite at the beginning and there must have been a bigger reason for his behavior towards the end. This should never be an excuse, but he had a really bad day and I can definitely identify with that. So, please I would hate for him to lose his job, be put on some sort of probation, etc. Unless, of course, this type of behavior is consistent.

What I would like is to get reimbursed for the suitcase that was damaged. It was my mom's, bought at Macy's for \$250.00. I was asked for the receipt, but I do not have it. Instead, I took the photos of the damaged suitcase and was going to find it online and figure out what it costs. The problem is, I spent hours looking for it and it's unavailable on any major websites, including amazon.com, ebay.com, overstock.com, macys.com, etc. It was Ellen Tracy limited collection suitcase (apparently this is a big deal in women's world) and it is unavailable for purchase. I did find a similar one of a different color on ebay with the same price and the original price (see attached photo). Original price is \$320, but my mom paid \$250. Feel free to browse on internet yourself, you won't be able to find it.

What you will find is that a regular, average "spinner" suitcase costs between \$150 - \$300 and that's not even a better quality suitcase like the one we had. So, I would like to be reimbursed in the amount of \$250 for the similar suitcase and all the inconvenience.

Thank you for addressing this issue to my satisfaction and for taking a professional approach to this situation. I spoke with Elizabeth on the phone and she was very polite and professional and gave me all the info I needed, as well as explained the process of handling these types of situations.

Good afternoon

I am writing this email in hopes of receiving an answer regarding the recent experience I've had with one of your drivers. Immediately after a drop off, I called the number and was instructed to email you regarding what happened.

On Thursday, June 4th, 2015, my girlfriend and I were picked up approximately around 5:00 pm in front of the bus/train station on St. Paul avenue, here in Milwaukee. I believe the car number was 493—it was a van, driven by an older gentleman, who I believe is originally from Jamaica... This wasn't a scheduled call, my girlfriend and I just walked up to the van and he was very nice to greet us and help us with our suitcases. We had four large suitcases, one small one and a backpack. As there were a lot of cars and we were all kind of in a rush, he tried to load the suitcases as fast as he could, during which process he broke one of them, as he didn't know how to retract the handle, so he just jammed it with his fist. Upon realizing it was broken, he just left it the way it was, risking an even worse damage and threw it on top of other suitcases.

We told him to drop us off at _____ g. located at _____ I am not sure what the speed limit was, but the gentleman was driving at one point what I believe to be 55mph or faster, passing cars in the right lane, accelerating and stopping aggressively for absolutely no reason. My girlfriend had to grab a hold of me couple of times as she was obviously disturbed.

Once we were dropped off, my girlfriend and him unloaded the suitcases and I was paying for the fare, which was \$7.50. Annoyed with him breaking the \$250 suitcase and for driving like a maniac, I didn't leave the tip. As I was in the process of going inside of the building, my girlfriend reminded me to grab a receipt, which I need for my company for expense reporting, as I used a company credit card. I quickly ran back to the van and asked for a receipt and he said "I don't have a receipt for this kind of s***!" He is saying that as the receipt is being printed. At this point, he is holding it at his hand, completely refusing to give me a receipt and goes on and on about me not leaving the tip: "I am not giving you a receipt... I am losing money on this... I only get to keep 10% of what I charge you... I am trying to help you and this is how you treat me... I am not giving you a receipt... why didn't you leave the tip... what kind of a man are you." These were his exact words. I am leaning into the window, on the passenger side, explaining I need the receipt and he starts driving away as I am still very close to the car. I told him "since you broke the suitcase, you don't get the tip, I guess we'll call it even."

At that point, he stops the car, gets out of the car and starts yelling at me in front of the building in front of other people, yet again about how he was trying to help, how I am not a good person. He then pulled out a stack of cash from his pocket and starts yelling "Do you want me to pay? Why didn't you tip me? I am losing money on this!" He then starts telling me how he didn't break the suitcase, as I am clearly pointing to the handle that is completely destroyed, wedged into the suitcase, with the wire sticking out, completely useless. He is continuing to yell at me, saying he was trying to help, how I didn't tip and saying he didn't do it, but at the same time pulling cash and wanting to pay. At this point, my girlfriend is super upset and asking me to back off and let it go. I start walking back to her, because I just got back from a 30 hour trip and she just got back from Colombia and a 25 hour trip. As I am walking back, other people are staring at the guy as he is continuing to yell at me. If it weren't for my girlfriend, it was at a point I would have smacked him. I asked him why he was yelling and told him to lower his voice and I refused to give him a tip. He went back inside of his van and kept yelling at me until he drove away.

I reported this incident immediately after we were dropped off and was told to email you. I would not be spending time on this and calling, especially since I haven't seen my girlfriend in over six months and just got back dead tired from the trip. The experience was so memorable with this guy that I had to let somebody know right away. When I spoke with a very nice lady over the phone, she asked if there were any witnesses. I believe there are cameras in front of the building and our security guard was helping us with bags and she saw the whole thing. There were few other building tenants around the building but I don't know their names. Also, not sure how deep you want to get into this, but there are traffic cameras, showing how fast he was driving on the way to my home.

I would like to add that the guy was very pleasant at first, seemed like a very nice guy. Just before we arrived to my building, he received a phone call from what I understood to be a friend, possibly talking about a death in that friend's family. He was clearly sad, upset, was saying he was sorry, so I don't know if that was a reason for his reaction. I don't want him to get in trouble, he seemed like a nice guy, but I didn't not appreciate the fast driving, yelling at me in front of my girlfriend and other people and then breaking my suitcase.

All I want from this is somebody to talk to him, remind him not to act like a maniac, for his own good. Getting into people's faces and yelling at them never ends well. I also want someone to get in touch with me regarding my suitcase, as I would like to be reimbursed for it in the amount of \$250.00. I will take a photo of the suitcase if you need to see it and will attempt to find a same one online, or a similar one for your information and comparison.

Don't care at this point what happens to this guy, just want the money for a brand new suitcase. Any other info you need from me, please let me know.

It's a \$5 - \$6 dollar ride and you are giving me \$2 when I handed him a \$20??? Then after I called him out in his behavior he gave me a \$10 bill. This man is not only a dangerous driver he is a crook and a con man. He should NOT be driving a Yellow Cab - or ANY color cab for that matter under any circumstances. I am reporting him to the Milwaukee Division of Licensing . This is outrageous and unprofessional behavior. I ask that you take this matter seriously and dismiss this driver.

But when we returned home on the following Friday March 13th it was a different story (an International flight) and took the shuttle from the International arrival terminal over to the parking facility to get a Taxi to come back home we were directed to the Taxi that was in the front of the line. Other than a marking of TAXIMKE cab #119 I did not see any other markings. As we were pulling out of the parking facility I notice that was some dollar amount already showing on the meter (I think is about \$3 and some odd cents) and when I asked about this the driver made some type of comment that I didn't need to worry about it. I driver had a heavy accent (maybe Russian or Slavic) so it was hard to understand him. As we were heading out of the Airport I gave him my address and asked if he knew where the street was that I lived on, he said no so I told him I would give him directions. I told him when we reached Howell Ave. he was to turn right heading north towards Layton Ave. I further added that he was to stay in the right lane because we would also be turning right onto Layton Ave. The driver proceeded to go into the left lane and I didn't said anything right away because I thought maybe he was just going around a car but when he kept continuing in the left lane I told him again to get into the right lane because we had to turn right at Layton Ave. (which I had explained was the second stop and go light ahead of us. A cab driver arrived and was given \$140 in cash to take us both home. Shortly after that, this driver called another driver, Dalip Singh, cab #036, and he proceeded to ask me to get into his cab, while [REDACTED] stayed in the first cab. I was confused, and obviously would have questioned this, had I been more alert. Since [REDACTED] and I live only five minutes apart, [REDACTED] and the second cab was not necessary.

So, each cab drove us home separately, and when I arrived home, I was charged \$73 on my credit card, and an added tip to total \$91.25. I questioned the driver and mentioned that my ride was prepaid by the Legion Post, but he shook his head and said no. He then gave me his card, which gave me his name. [REDACTED] poke with Mr. Jonathan Koberstein and he told her Dalip Singh's cab #036.

Needless to say, Legion Post 449 is very upset about this, and so am I. [REDACTED] and I have since paid the Post back for their kindness, and I have paid twice, due to my credit card charge. Both [REDACTED] and I were taken advantage of, as was the Legion Post. This offense needs to be rectified.
