



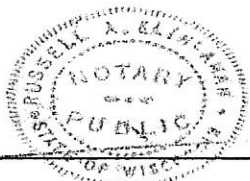

Pursuant to law, the Common Council has scheduled the Neighborhood Improvement District No. 8 (Walker's Point) Annual Meeting for Wednesday, January 25, 2017, at 6:00 p.m. at 234 West Florida Street, 5th Floor, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, at which time the election of Neighborhood Improvement District Board Members will be considered.

This notice declares that all individuals who either own or occupy real property within the District are eligible to serve on the Board and vote at the election.
