Dear Council Members:

Enclosed please find a resolution authorizing the release of a subrogation claim against Ann Marie Micklitz in exchange for a settlement payment of \$1,000.00.

Ms. Micklitz filed a personal injury lawsuit for injuries suffered in an automobile collision which occurred on October 10, 2001. The City has a claim against her for medical payments under the City's Basic Health Plan in a total amount of \$3,817.41.

As noted in the enclosed letter from counsel for WPS, the claims administrator for the Basic Health Plan, recovery of the full amount of the City's claim would require proof that all monies paid were for the purpose of treatment related to the automobile accident. There is evidence that medical treatment beyond the actual date of the accident was not related to injuries sustained in the accident. The City's claim for services on the date of the accident is in the amount of \$1,419.97. Under

these circumstances, Ms. Micklitz has offered \$1,000.00 in settlement of the City's claim. We recommend adoption of this resolution.
