Dear Council Members:

We return the enclosed document which has been filed with the City Clerk and ask that it be introduced and referred to the Committee on Judiciary & Legislation with the following recommendation.

Claimant, James E. Ashford, alleges through Liberty Mutual, by its representative, Barbara Grotzinger, 6575 Snowdrift Road, Suite 101, Allentown, PA 18106 as subrogee that on November 1, 2002 a City water main broke and flooded the street and that there was no salting done or warnings posted; as a result the claimant's vehicle slid on ice and was damaged. They claim damages in the amount of \$6,482.27.

Our investigation reveals that the Milwaukee Water Works records indicate that they received notice of a possible water main break in the area of 3416 North 4th Street at approximately 5:08 a.m. on November 1, 2002. At 5:41 a.m. a Water Works supervisor requested that catch basins in the area be cleared and that the area be salted. The six-inch main was throttled by 6:27 a.m. The break was located in a construction area where a private contractor was engaged in a water main re-lay project. The private contractor was American Sewer Services, 6151 O'Connell St. Hartford, WI 53027. Water Works served notices to surrounding property owners and the main was turned off by 7:18 a.m. Because the break was located in the construction area, American Sewer Services made the necessary repairs. The Milwaukee Water Works followed

standard procedures in this matter regarding the response and repair. In addition, they immediately requested that the catch basins be cleared and the area salted. As such, the City would not be liable. Accordingly, we recommend that this claim be denied.

SUBJECT: Property Damage claim of James Ashford C.I. File 02-L-155

In accordance with your request of December 3, 2002, we have investigated the subject claim.

Our investigation revealed that a possible main break in the area of 3416 North 4th Street was reported to the Milwaukee Water Works at approximately 5:08 a.m. on November 1, 2002. By 5:41 a.m., our supervisor reported from the site, where he called for catch basins in the area to be cleared and also for the location to be salted. At 6:27 a.m, our investigators reported that they had throttled a six-inch main break at the subject location. The break was located in a construction area, where American Sewer Services was engaged in a water main re-lay project

Notices were served and the main was turned off by 7:18 a.m. Because the break was located in the contractor's excavation, American Sewer Services made the necessary repairs.

It is our view that the Milwaukee Water Works followed standard procedures regarding the response to and repair of the main break in this case. In addition, we feel we acted responsibly by immediately requesting salting for the area and for the catch basins to be cleared. We feel we are not liable for any damages this case, and accordingly, we recommend that the claim be denied.
