There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.

Re: ABC Liquor at 3901 W Vliet.

As a resident and business owner I am concerned about the amount of litter generated by this store. Neighbors complain about constantly having to pick up litter and alcohol bottles. As a concerned resident and neighbor, I do clean-ups in the area and along Vliet. There is a drastic difference in the amount of litter in the neighborhood from one side of Highland to the other. I attribute much of this to ABC customers who toss there containers out the window or on the ground when walking home. 





Mr SAJAN stated that he has given this employee training about how to handle problem activities and how and when to utilize police services. Mr SAJAN also stated that he has placed a lot of signage on his property (No Loitering etc) and brought in pictures of the signage. Mr SAJAN stated that their problems with panhandling and problem customers at the location have decreased. Mr SAJAN also utilizes a security guard to patrol the outside and inside of the gas station on weekends. Mr SAJAN said that he will remain cooperative with the police department and continue consistent communication. Mr SAJAN stated that he has a good working relationship with the neighboring business owners as well.

Mr SAJAN stated that he intends to keep the 24 hour time frame unless there are future issues and

INITIAL INVESTIGATION

This report is written by P.O. William VAN LAANEN, assigned to District 3, Late Shift.

On Tuesday, October 23, 2018 at approximately 11:52 PM, Squad 3341 (P.O. Alexander NUTER and I, both in full duty uniform and operating a marked MPD squad car) was dispatched to a Fight call for service at 2242 N 12th St (Clark Gas Station), located in the city and county of Milwaukee, WI.

Upon arrival, we observed a black mini-van in front of the business and could hear yelling. We approached the front entrance and observed a black male wearing all black clothing kicking and punching the door to the business while yelling. The caller/reporting person, identified as Mirza BAIG (A/M, 08/02/63), was observed holding the door closed from the inside of the business while the subject was striking the door. We announced ourselves as police and ordered the subject to stop. The subject continued to yell and cause a disturbance so I took control of the subject's right arm, while P.O. NUTER took control of his left arm. The subject began to tense up and pull his arms away from our control. I ordered the subject to "stop resisting" but the subject continued to try and pull away. The subject was then directed to the ground and cuffed by P.O. NUTER. We placed the subject in the rear of our squad car (013). The subject verbally identified himself as Dalvin J. WILLIAMS (B/M, 06/29/97) and stated he was assaulted by someone inside the gas station. WILLIAMS was intoxicated and hard to understand. I spoke with BAIG who stated WILLIAMS thought he had paid for items in the store but he actually didn't. When WILLIAMS was confronted by staff, he began to yell and make a scene. WILLIAMS was asked to leave and then pushed out of the store. While out of the store, BAIG and other customers held the door closed. BAIG then called police. BAIG stated the incident caused him to have a panic attack and received medical attention on scene. Other customers were uncooperative and would not talk to police, stating "fuck 12" and "we don't talk to police."

I tried to review surveillance video from the store but the cameras did not record the event and did not seem to be working properly.

BAIG was issued a PV-17 on scene.

WILLIAMS refused medical attention on scene but was conveyed by us to St. Mary's Hospital for medical clearance. WILLIAMS was then conveyed to D3 for processing.

WILLIAMS stated he was just trying to buy cigarettes but the clerk refused so he became angry. WILLIAMS stated he tried to leave the store but people kept putting hands on him and keeping him there.


