Dear Mr. Zielinski:

The Health Department is submitting grant resolutions for the following programs:

Sexually Transmitted Diseases Grant - This is a continuing grant funded by the State of Wisconsin Division of Health and Family Services. The purpose of the funding is to reduce the incidence and complications of sexually transmitted diseases in Milwaukee through preventive health education services and focused disease intervention activities.

Lead Poisoning Prevention Grant - This continuing grant from the State of Wisconsin Division of Health and Family Services will support the comprehensive and coordinated services to lead-poisoned children and their families. Services include screening, laboratory analysis, nursing care management, environmental inspections, community health education and program management.

Fetal Infant Mortality Review Grant - This continuation funding comes to the City from the U. S. Department of Health and Human Services through the Black Health Coalition. The grant will resume the interdisciplinary review of infant deaths (and some fetal deaths) occurring in the City of Milwaukee to identify opportunities to reduce infant mortality and support families at risk.

None of the above funding includes changes to the Positions Ordinance. All appropriate paperwork is attached. Thank you for your consideration.
