WHEREAS, Pride Month honorees are exemplary champions in the Milwaukee community who demonstrate outstanding contributions in civic, professional, and humanitarian pursuits; and

WHEREAS, The Milwaukee LGBT Community Center seeks to further develop the vibrant lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender community in the greater Milwaukee area, thus improving the quality of life for everyone, by believing in the goodness of lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender people, and fostering wider community development and inclusion; and
