The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 04/01/2011 the applicant was cited for Operating While Intoxicated. He was convicted on 05/04/2011 and his license was revoked for 9 months.

2. On 04/18/2020 at 10:49pm officers were dispatched to investigate a possible COVID-19 violation at Juniors Cocktail Lounge, 3300 W. Lincoln Av. The caller stated there were subjects sitting down and drinking alcoholic beverages. When the officer arrived the front door was locked but they looked through the window and observed people sitting at the bar with items in front of them. The officer knocked on the window and the people started putting the items away. The applicant opened the door for the officers and stated the people were waiting for food. the officers advised the applicant no one could wait inside and no liquor could be served. The applicant stated he was unaware of the safer at home orders. The officers explained the order to him and he stated he had no questions. The patrons left without incident.

3. On 08/27/2020 officers, along with agents from Wisconsin Department of Revenue, conducted a licensed premise check at Junior's Cocktail Lounge, 3300 W. Lincoln Av. Officers observed a security guard at the door checking ID's and monitoring capacity. There were 20 patrons inside, who were wearing masks when not eating, drinking or smoking Hookahs. The agent found the applicant was selling hookah and allowing the smoking of hookah inside without a

license. The Department of Revenue agent seized the hookah and the applicant was issued citations.

5. On 12/17/2020 an officer spoke with the manager of the apartment building at 3227 W. Lincoln Av about complaints he has received from his tenants about Junior's Cocktail Lounge at 3300 W. Lincoln Av. The manager stated his tenants complain about the noise level of the patrons as they enter and leave, the use of their parking lot by patrons and the amount of trash left behind. The officers located 15 calls for serve in the past 90 days. The officer advised the manager for the tenant to call with concerns and to possibly testify at a license committee meeting.

## Narrative (1)

### INITIAL INVESTIGATION

Arnold, Quentin C 029412

This report is being written by Police Officer (P.O.) Quentin C. ARNOLD, assigned to District 2 Late Power Shift squad 2557. I was equipped with an AXON body worn camera, which captured this investigation.

On Saturday, April 18th, 2020 at approximately 10:49P.M., (While in full duty Milwaukee Police Uniform operating a marked Milwaukee Police Squad) arrived at Juniors Cocktail Lounge located at 3300 W. Lincoln Ave, which is located in the City and County of Milwaukee, WI to investigate a operating non essential business during to COVID-19 pandemic.

An anonymous caller stated that there were subjects inside of the tavern sitting down and, drinking alcoholic beverages. When I attempted to call the caller back I was unable to reach them after multiple attempts.

### INTERVIEW OF CALLOWAY

Upon arriving at the tavern the main business door located at the intersection of 3300 W. Lincoln was locked. I looked inside of the taverns windows and observed several subjects sitting at the bar on the north side. When I knocked on the glass they began putting items behind the bar in attempt to clean the area. Eventually a subject opened the door who I identified by Wisconsin Driver License as CALLOWAY, Edward R, B/M, 12/28/1983, 1612 S. 76th Street, C# 414-306-5285. CALLOWAY stated he is the owner of Junior's Cocktail Lounge.

CALLOWAY stated that the subjects were sitting down inside because they were waiting for their food. When asked if he was aware he could not have anyone sitting down inside of the tavern he stated he was unaware of the safer at home orders. I explained to CALLOWAY he was unable to have customers sitting down inside waiting for their food. I then asked CALLOWAY if he was serving liquor inside of the tavern. CALLOWAY at first stated no but, then stated he served somebody a margarita. I informed CALLOWAY that he is not able to operate as a tavern during the order as well.

I asked CALLOWAY if we could resolve the issue by no longer allowing individuals inside the bar to pick up their food. I asked CALLOWAY if it was a possibly if he could have curb side pick up for food and, he complied and stated that he would change his Facebook post to inform his customer base. I informed CALLOWAY that a tavern report will be written about the events that occurred tonight. I also explained the safer at home order again before asking if CALLOWAY had any questions. CALLOWAY stated that I explained everything that he had questions about.

All patrons then left the establishment without incident.

Matthew DIENER and I) assisted WI. Dept. of Revenue Special Agent Georgeann KING with an inspection of Junior's Cocktail Lounge, located at 3300 W Lincoln Av. Officers were in full uniform and equipped with body-worn cameras.

Officers approached the location and observed a security guard outside of the premises who was checking IDs, "wandering" patrons as they entered, and monitoring capacity. Officers observed approximately 20 patrons who were wearing masks when not eating, drinking, or smoking from hookahs. Officers spoke with the licensee, Edward R CALLOWAY, who was on scene and cooperative throughout the investigation. The investigation revealed that CALLOWAY offered for sale and allowed patrons to smoke tobacco products from hookahs inside of the premises (enclosed place) and that CALLOWAY did not possess a license to do so and that the premises did not meet any of the exceptions that would allow for smoking inside of the location. Agent KING did seize 19 units of open and sealed hookah tobacco of various sizes and flavors.

while assigned to Squad 2166, I spoke with Jackie KEMENY (414)737-5933, regarding Junior's Cocktail Lounge, located at 3300 W Lincoln Av. KEMENY is the property manager for an apartment building at 3227 W Lincoln Av and called after receiving on-going complaints from tenants of 3227 W Lincoln Av regarding Junior's Cocktail Lounge. KEMENY stated that tenants have repeatedly complained of the noise level from patrons of Junior's before they enter the location and after they leave. KEMENY stated that patrons of the tavern often park in the parking lot of 3227 W Lincoln Av without permission, leave garbage behind, and drink and/or smoke marijuana in their vehicles.

I asked that KEMENY urge the tenants to place calls to the non-emergency number, contacted their Alderperson, and/or give testimony regarding the premises at a license hearing if one occurs.

I then checked the calls for service to Junior's Cocktail Lounge and found there to be fifteen (15) noise complaints at the location in the past ninety days. The calls were placed between 12:00 am and 2:30 am from mostly one resident in the neighborhood and the calls were either closed with a C15 (officers would often arrive after the patrons had left the area) and a C10 (advised the caller of the disposition). I did speak with the subject who placed the majority of the calls and he stated that he was aware that the license was up for renew in January and planned on giving testimony if he was able to do so.

I attempted to reach the licensee by phone, but received no answer and left a message asking that CALLOWAY return my call.
