INDICATION FOR EXAM: Fracture of left ankle. Evaluate.

FINDINGS: Cast material is present overlying the left ankle, obscuring bony detail.

There is re-demonstration of the comminuted fracture through the lateral malleolus extending above the tibia-fibular syndesmosis. The syndesmosis is widened and appears slightly more widened than on the previous exam. There is interval increase in the widening of the medial ankle mortise. No new fracture is identified.

IMPRESSION:

- 1. Interval increase in the widening at the tibia-fibular syndesmosis and at the medial ankle mortise as described above.
- Stable alignment of the comminuted lateral malleolus fracture.

DATE OF SERVICE: 03/02/2005

Mr. Bryant is a 44-year-old man who comes in after having injured his left ankle over the weekend when he slipped on some ice. He was seen in the emergency room and splinted and presents now for further evaluation and treatment. He denies any other injuries.

PAST MEDICAL HISTORY: He states that he is otherwise healthy, although he admits to some type of psychiatric diagnosis, it appears that he may have a mild degree of mental retardation.

MEDICATIONS: Vicodin.

ALLERGIES: None known.

HABITS: He denies use of tobacco or significant use of alcohol. He denies use of drugs.

REVIEW OF SYSTEMS: Is obtained, but is noncontributory.

PHYSICAL EXAMINATION: Shows the ankle is quite swollen both medially and laterally. The skin, however, is intact. There is no proximal tenderness. The ankle appears to be unstable by exam.

X-rays taken in the emergency room demonstrate a displaced lateral malleolus fracture. The medial clear space is not certainly widened, although the lateral view suggests some subluxation. X-rays repeated today show a significant medial clear space widening with displacement of his lateral malleolus fracture.

IMPRESSION: Unstable lateral maileolus fracture.

RECOMMENDATIONS: I offered this patient surgical procedure today as he has been made NPO, however, appropriate time was not available. Therefore, he will be admitted within the next 48 hours for surgical treatment of his problem. The risks and potential complications associated with surgery to include medical or anesthetic complications of a significant degree - DVT, pulmonary embolus, infection, and consequence of failure, fixation, and failure of the operation to achieve its desired result. This was discussed in the presence of his friend with whom he lives. They both appear to understand and appear to be reasonably able to make
