continue to the front door of District #2. He states that as GOURDOUS exited the front door he stated, "fuck you" and then proceeded to walk west bound. Officer HERNANDEZ reports that at no time did he witness anyone strike complainant GOURDOUS.

CONCLUSION:

On Friday, October 1, 1999 this incident was reviewed in the office of the District Attorney. The complainant Joseph GOURDOUS, however, failed to appear at the District Attorney's office. On Tuesday, October 5, 1999 complainant GOURDOUS was contacted by telephone at which time he reported that his failure to appear was due to the revocation of his drivers license status and therefore had no transportation to the District Attorney's office. Complainant GOURDOUS, however, offered that he wished to proceed with this matter. On Wednesday, October 20, 1999 an attempt to contact Mr. GOURDOUS was unsuccessful due to the disconnection of his telephone service. It should be noted that complainant GOURDOUS does reside in Union Grove, Wisconsin. On Thursday, October 21, 1999 ADA Thomas MCADAMS did decline to issue criminal charges against Officer Joseph ANDERER. In addition to complainant GOURDOUS' lack of commitment to pursue his complaint ADA Thomas MCADAMS did offer his belief that he could not prove beyond a reasonable doubt complainant GOURDOUS' allegation of battery perpetrated by P.O. ANDERER. It is for said reasons that this incident will be cleared as warrant refused.
