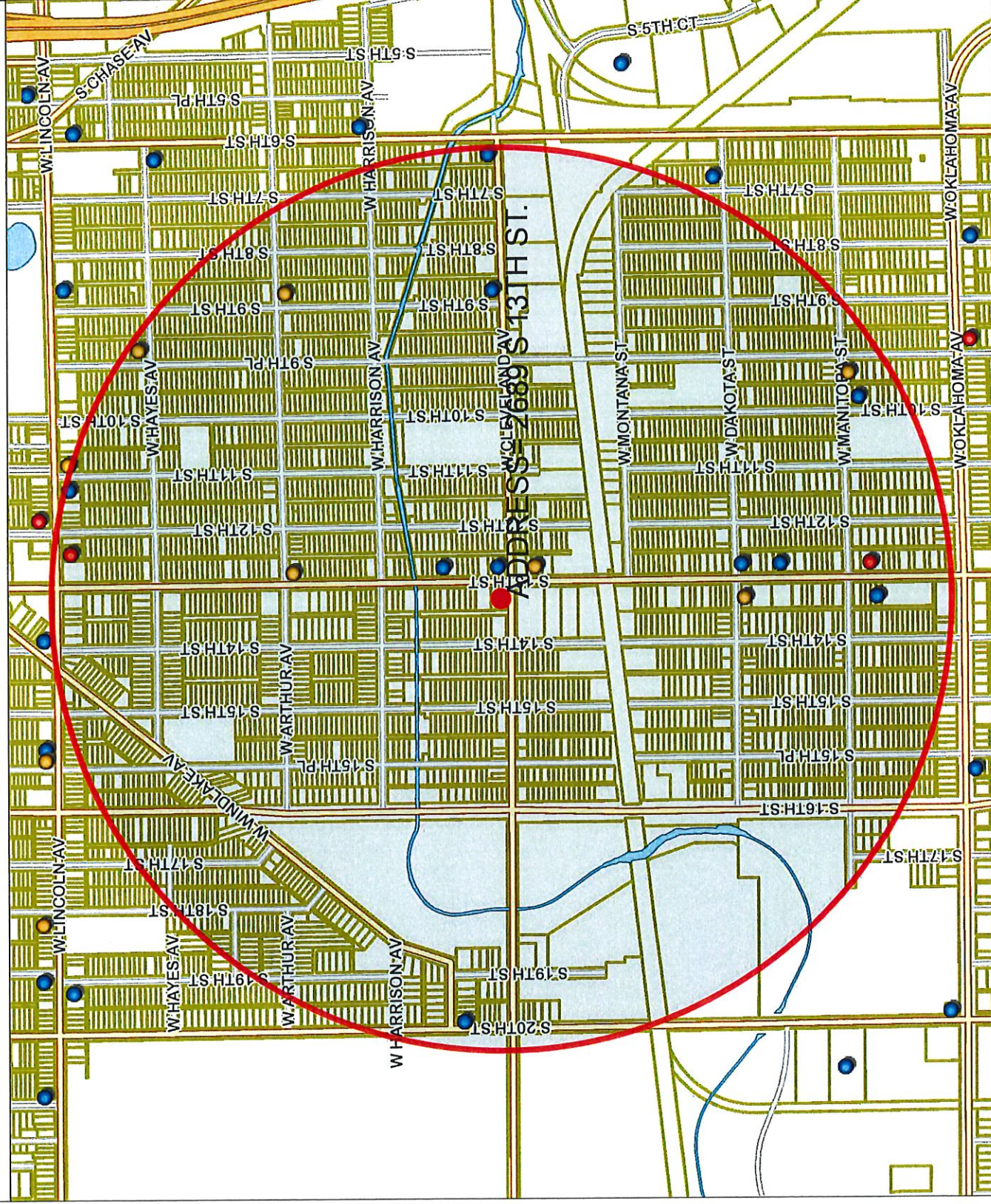

He stated there was a band that night but they were using instruments that were not amplified. He stated all doors and windows were closed. The applicant was cooperative with officers.

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12. On 03/23/2018 officers responded to Casa Vieja tavern, 1629 S 10th St, to assist the Wisconsin Department of Revenue with an inspection. The owner, Byron GUDIEL and bar manager Yomary REYES, were on scene and cooperative during the inspection. The inspectors found 110 bottles of alcohol with no proof of purchase and cigarettes with Kentucky tax stamps. The investigation revealed that REYES was paying GUDIEL \$2,500 per month to operate the premise under his license.

13. On 03/24/2018 officers responded to 1629 S 10th St, which is now known as La Rumba, for a Noise Nuisance. The officers heard loud bass coming from La Rumba. They spoke with the bar manager, Yomary REYES, who agreed to turn down the music.
