- 2. On 04/23/23 at 2:32a.m., Milwaukee Police were flagged down for a fight at 721 S. Cesar Chavez. The officers interviewed the agent who was on scene. The agent stated a physical fight took place between two patrons and they hired security immediately broke it up. The agent was very cooperative and provided officers with video surveillance of the incident.
- 3. On 05/05/23 at 5:26a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Reckless Use of A Weapon at 721 S. Cesar Chavez. On arrival officers were met by the caller who stated at approximately 3:40a.m., the business had been shot up and windows were broken. The agent provided video surveillance of the incident and stated they did not have any problems with anyone and did not know why this was done.

4. On 05/30/23 at 7:00p.m., a citizen walked into the District to report a stabbing that occurred at 721 S. Cesar Chavez on 04/23/23. The victim provided video of the incident to the officers. The video depicts the victim outside the establishment and was attempting to pull their friend away from a fight, when the suspect approaches with a pocket knife and swings it at the victim, causing two lacerations to the chest, requiring stitches. It should be noted this fight was unrelated to the fight in Incident #2.

Upon arrival at approximately 2:32 am we made contact with Squad 2416, Sgt Jonathan MEJIA who was flagged down at the location for a physical altercation. Sgt MEJIA advised us that there was physical fight between individuals' leaving the business. While on scene we spoke with the owner of the establishment identified as Juan M CABRAL-DORADO (w/m 07/12/1988). CABRAL-DORADO was cooperative and stated to us that was a physical fight between his customers leaving the business. CABRAL-DORADO provided us with his licensing to the business and his information. CABRAL-DORADO allowed officers to view his camera footage regarding the physical fight.

CABRAL-DORADO stated that his security had broken up the fight and prevented any further altercation between the subjects. CABRAL-DORADO stated the security company he hired is Eagle Destiny Public Safety.

The video of the depicted a mutual fight and the primary aggressor to be the subject on scene. The other subject was not on scene at the time to report the incident. No citations were issued regarding the mutual fight between the subjects.

Juan stated a total of seven windows were damaged and there were some casings found which the windows were struck.

MA Guadalupe stated that she did not suspect of anyone wanting to do harm to their family or their property. She stated that she is always in the location and tends to stay there late and has not seen anyone suspicious around the area.

JUAN stated they have not had any problems with anyone, and he also does not suspect of anyone.

On Sunday April 23rd, 2023, at approximately 2:30 AM PO CARLONI and I responded to 721 S Cesar E. Chavez which is located in the City and County of Milwaukee WI for fight case #23-113-0025.

PO CARLONI and I responded to assist Squad 2416 Sgt. Jonathon MEJIA-RIVERA due to him being flagged down for a fight. It was determined that the fight was mutual. Owner of the bar was cooperative on scene and was able to provide the video surveillance of that one particular fight.

It should be noted that we were not flagged down or notified about any other fights that occurred that night.

On Tuesday, May 30th, 2023, 7:00PM victim identified as Cesar O. VILLALOBOS-QUEZADA (w/m 06-14-1991) entered District Two to report an incident that occurred the same night 04-23-23 at approximately 2:30 AM. VILLALOBOS-QUEZADA stated he engaged in physical fight and was stabbed with a pocketknife causing two large lacerations across his chest, requiring a total of 16 stitches. VILLALOBOS-QUEZADA was able to provide photos of the injuries as well as a video of the fight which occurred outside of the establishment.

It should be noted this fight was not related to the fight we responded to prior.

The video depicted a large group of male subjects exiting the establishment. The males walk outside and began to have a physical altercation amongst each other. VILLALOBOS-QUEZADA is observed in the video attempting to grab his friend to exit the fight and in doing so the suspect approaches them with what appeared to be a pocketknife and swings it at them cutting VILLALOBOS-QUEZADA. It appears that when VILLALOBAS-QUEZADA notices he has a laceration to chest everyone disperses the area.

VILLALOBOS-QUEZADA was able to provide the video which was placed on MPD inventory #23017486.

Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.

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
