Install traffic calming speed hump(s).

4th Aldermanic District

N. 26th St. – W. McKinley Ave. to W. Vliet St. (ST211100157):
Install traffic calming speed hump(s).

Approve with late billing by Ald. Donovan. Prevailed 5-0.

6th Aldermanic District

E./W. Wright St. – N. Palmer St. to N. 2nd St. (ST211100146):
Install traffic calming speed hump(s).

Bob Bryson, Department of Public Work-Traffic and Engineering
Ken Herro, 6599 N. Bethmaur Lane, Glendale, owns a property on 1st and Wright St.,
and is against the speed humps.
Elaine Herro, 6599 N. Bethmaur Lane, Glendale, is against the speed humps.
Fanny Smith, 116 W. Wright St., is against the speed humps.
Sijuwade Olusegun, 102 E. Wright St., is more in support of a roundabout and is unsure
about the speed humps. He is also concerned about regulatory signs being vandalized.

Jeff Gurgle, 2503 N. Palmer St., is in favor of the speed humps.

David Ballard, 117 W. Wright St., is against the speed humps and in favor of regulatory signs.

Kathleen West, 2476 N. 2nd St., is against the speed humps.

Tara Ferguson, 2505 N. 1st St., is in support of the speed humps.

Ald. Wade says that the alderwoman of the district is leaving the decision up to the discretion of the committee.

Mr. Bryson submitted traffic and speed study results to the committee.

Approval by Ald. Donovan. Failed 2-3. (Ald. Wade, Ald. Puente and Ald. Dudzik voting "no")

Ald. Dudzik moves to place on file. Prevailed 5-0.

9th Aldermanic District

W. Calumet Rd. – N. 51st Blvd. to N. 60th St. (ST21100156):

Asphalt pavement with rural cross-section. Replace driveways as necessary and install traffic calming speed hump(s).

No neighborhood residents appearing. Ald. Puente says that the majority of residents at a neighborhood meeting were in favor of the paving and in opposition to the speed humps

Ald. Puente moves to amend the project to remove the installation of speed humps. Prevailed 5-0.

Ald. Puente moves to approve with extended late billing, as amended. Prevailed 5-0.

W. County Line Rd. – N. 91st St./Swan Rd. to N. 124th St./N. Wasauke Rd. (Portions in the City of Mequon) (ST211100131):

Asphalt pavement with rural cross-section. Replace driveways as necessary.

Ald. Puente moves to approve w/extended late billing. Prevailed 5-0.

11th Aldermanic District

Alley between W. Leroy Ave., W. Plainfield Ave., S. 51st St., and S. 52nd St. (ST212030103):

Concrete alley pavement reconstruction, replace some abutting walk or driveway approaches, grading, and storm drainage facilities where necessary.

Motion to approve by Ald. Dudzik with late billing. Prevailed 5-0.

13th Aldermanic District

S. 6th St. – A point 700 feet m/l north of W. College Ave. to 2000 feet m/l north of W. College Ave. (ST211100124):

Concrete pavement reconstruction, place all curb and gutter, install sidewalk and driveway approaches, sodding (5.0-foot width of tree border area), and grading.

Ms. Dziwiontkowski says that the alderman did not receive any postcards back.

Foster Finco, 6001 S. 6th St., requests that DPW put new utilities in before reconstruction. He also is against the sidewalk installation on both sides of the road, but is support of the road project.

Bruce Krogstad, 6025 S. 6th St., is opposed to the sidewalks but supports the road project.

Greg Lindner, 6055 S. 6th St., is opposed to sidewalks on both sides of the road but is support of the road project.

Clark Wantoch, Infrastructure Services, Department of Administration

Ald. Donovan moves to amend to provide only one sidewalk on the west side of the street

Ald. Donovan moves approval with late billing.

14th Aldermanic District

E. Howard Ave. – A point east of the Lake Parkway to a point east of S. Kansas Ave. (Sponsored by the City of St. Francis) (ST211100158):

Concrete pavement reconstruction, replace all curb and gutter, replace sidewalk and driveway approaches where necessary, sodding (8.0-foot width of tree border area), and grading.

No residents appearing.

Ald. Zielinski is in support of the project per Ms. Dziwiontkowski.

Ald. Dudzik moves approval. Prevailed 5-0.
