## **Proposal**

Remove chimney from rear slope of roof to below the roofline and patch the roof with matching slate and copper gutters.

## Staff comments

The applicant has had three roofing contractors examine the chimney and all have concluded that the chimney is in an unsafe condition and a full rebuild above the roofline would be required if the chimney were to stay. While repair is always preferred, our guidelines do allow for unused chimneys that are not a significant decorative or architectural feature to be removed (*Living With History*, p. 20). This chimney is on the rear slope of the roof and while a prominent feature when viewed from behind the house, it is not visible from the right of way. The chimney was originally for an incinerator, which is no longer used.

**Recommendation** Approve

**Conditions** The roof shall be repaired/patched per the Wisconsin Historical Society's slate roofing
