REASON FOR REQUEST:

Addo Williams, a City of Milwaukee Department of Public Works employee, was in the scope of his employment and standing next to a City of Milwaukee sanitation truck that was stopped in an alley near 3831 North 51st Blvd. As Mr. Williams was readying the garbage bin, the uninsured motorist, who was fleeing from the police and traveling northbound in the alley, failed to yield the right-of-way, striking Mr. Williams. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. §62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Mr. Williams, sustained injuries to his neck, back and left leg. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$17,560.20.
