No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition attend the virtual hearing and are willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should request an interpreter attend the meeting with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

It was brought to my attention that a client under our supervision, Tanya Pirlot, has applied for a Class D Operator License from the City of Milwaukee. Tanya Pirlot is currently on an Extended Supervision term that is scheduled to discharge on 9/23/21 for the offense of 2nd-Degree Recklessly Endangering Safety.

This letter is to inform you that such a licensure would not be in violation of their rules/conditions of supervision. If circumstances change, we will take measures appropriately, including action that may affect such licensure. We made this decision based in part, on the following information:

A - Residence Stability: Client has maintained residence stability **Yes**.

B - Reporting History: Client has maintained required contacts with agent **Yes**.

C - Police Contact: Client has had police contact while on supervision **Yes**.

D - Overall level of cooperation: has client complied with referrals and services designed to address criminogenic needs **Yes**.
