..Analysis

This ordinance repeals the requirement that the board of zoning appeals, prior to the granting of a special use permit, make a finding that the special use will be designed, located and operated in a manner consistent with all applicable elements of the city's comprehensive plan.

This ordinance also creates a provision stating that the board shall, in deciding if a special use permit shall be granted, consider whether the special use will be designed, located and operated in a manner consistent with any applicable element of the city's comprehensive plan, to the extent that this consistency relates to the board's consideration of the 3 findings it is required to make when reviewing and granting a special use permit.

..Body

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee do ordain as follows:

Part 1. Section 295-311-2-d-4 of the code is repealed.

(Note: The provision being repealed reads as follows:

295-311. Appeals.
