PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the above-named Claimant states that the following circumstances give rise to a claim:

1. That on or about June 6, 2008, a sewer blockage occurred in a City-owned sewer located near Claimant's residence at 3908 N. 63<sup>rd</sup> Street.

2. That large quantities of water flooded the street and the Lawrence yard.

3. That upon information and belief, negligent maintenance of the City owned sewer, appurtenances thereto, and the City street in which the same are located, contributed to the blockage and subsequent flooding.
