1. Description of Grant Project/Program (Include Target Locations and Populations):

Milwaukee is a known transportation hub for human trafficking. Human trafficking victims are often transported across state lines to destination cities. Due to the dynamics associated with human trafficking, it remains one of the most underreported index offenses across the United States. Prosecuted cases involve lengthy, complex investigations that include multiple victims identified by law enforcement. In cooperation with the Sojourner Family Peace Center, Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office and numerous other state and federal partners, we propose creating the Milwaukee Joint Human Trafficking Task Force to improve collaboration and offer comprehensive, quality services to trafficking victims. This includes hiring an additional part-time analyst position and two full time investigator positions to cope with the additional volume of cases and to address gaps in coordination between local, state, and federal partners and services.

This resolution is consistent with the mission and vision of the Milwaukee Police Department to enhance public safety and combat organized crime through victim oriented, community based policing.
