I am against a slaughterhouse. I grew up in Green Bay where the smell from Green Bay Packaging carried across the entire city on a hot summer night. I am a vegetarian and have been for 30 years. I also worked for potawatoni casino about 4 or so years ago.

When I went for orientation Cargil slaughterhouse was there. I said I will not work near a slaughterhouse and thankfully it closed before I started working.

I know the casino would have lost business if it had stayed. I was told by other casino workers that when Cargil was there often pieces of meat would fall from the sky from birds that tried to carry them away. Even an avid meat eater would be disgusted.

If a slaughterhouse comes, I will sell my house and move. I can also predict that it will prevent young educated and technical people from taking jobs in Milwaukee. The more educated and liberal a young person is the more likely they are to be vegan or vegetarian. Even meat eaters do not want to live near the smell and image of animals being slaughtered.

if Milwaukee wants to be considered more segregated, violent and non-progressive than it is already perceived I imagine building a slaughterhouse is a good idea. If the city wants to move into the 21st with the rest of the civilized world it needs to be stopped.

The first I saw of this was on the news this morning. The city politicians should be embarrassed and ashamed they were talking about such a horrific venture while keeping the

people of Milwaukee in the dark. I know you are a good and sincere human being so please stop this.
