
REASON FOR REQUEST:

Frank Heeg, a City of Milwaukee Police Officer, was in the scope of his employment and a passenger in a City of Milwaukee squad car that was traveling southbound on South Cesar E Chavez Drive. After the City vehicle stopped at a red light at the intersection of South Cesar E Chavez Drive and West Greenfield Avenue, the uninsured motorist, who was traveling southbound on South Cesar E Chavez Drive at a high rate of speed, failed to yield the right of way and rear-ended another vehicle causing that vehicle to be pushed into the City vehicle, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Officer Heeg sustained injuries to his head, neck and back. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$6,303.72.
