The total estimated cost of this project is \$45,271.77 for the alteration and upgrade of traffic control signals and the upgrade of traffic control signs. Twenty percent (20%) of the participating cost or \$9,054.35 will be City funded and the eighty percent (80%) will be funded by Wisconsin Department of Transportation.
