2. On 02/21/2015 officers investigated an incident at 4950 W. Lisbon Ave. The investigation revealed that at about 9:19pm, two employees, Rajpal SINGH and Vishal VISHAL, confronted a shoplifter, Dominic SMITH. When the SMITH refused to leave SINGH armed himself with a bat and VISHAL armed himself with a wooden stick. SINGH struck SMITH in the arm with the bat and chased him from the store. SMITH throws a garbage can at the store and SINGH chased SMITH from the property. SMITH then returns and takes the bat from SINGH and attacks both employees striking them in the head. Both were conveyed to the hospital. SINGH had a skull fracture and bleeding on the brain and VISHAL had several lacerations to the head. SMITH was arrested.
